Dentistry First has announced the appointment of Dr. Calvin Kundi as a Senior Associate Dentist at its Mooloolaba practice. Dr. Kundi joins the clinic with professional experience gained in London, where he developed a broad clinical background across general and restorative dentistry prior to relocating to the Sunshine Coast.

Dr. Kundi completed his dental degree with multiple distinctions from Barts and the London School of Medicine and Dentistry, one of the world's leading institutions for dental education. His appointment follows a period of sustained growth at Dentistry First, which has expanded both its clinical team and service range over recent months in response to increasing patient demand across the region.

The addition of a practitioner with international clinical training carries practical significance for a regional practice. Dental education at Barts and the London School of Medicine and Dentistry is governed by the General Dental Council and is internationally benchmarked, exposing graduates to high patient volumes and varied case complexity across both general and specialist disciplines. For Dentistry First, Dr. Kundi's appointment strengthens the breadth of clinical experience available to patients at the Mooloolaba clinic.

"Our patients expect consistency and a high level of clinical care regardless of who they see, and his appointment supports that."

Dentistry First is located at 1/45 First Avenue, Mooloolaba, and serves patients from across the Sunshine Coast region. The practice provides general check-ups and cleans, cosmetic dentistry, dental implants, dentures, root canal treatment, and emergency dental services within a single clinic setting. Dr. Kundi joins Principal Dentists Dr. Jason Phan and Dr. Jen Phan, as well as Associate Dentist Dr. Nadia Qin, in delivering care across this full range of services.

The Sunshine Coast has recorded consistent population growth over the past decade, a trend that has placed measurable pressure on the availability of local dental services. The Australian Institute of Health and Welfare has identified workforce distribution as a key factor in access to dental care in non-metropolitan regions. The appointment of Dr. Kundi directly addresses this dynamic, increasing the capacity of Dentistry First to manage patient demand without extending wait times or reducing appointment availability.

Dr. Kundi noted that the decision to join Dentistry First was shaped by the practice's clinical culture and its commitment to patient-centred care. Originally from the United Kingdom, he now resides on the Sunshine Coast, having made the transition from a high-volume clinical environment in London to a practice setting that places equal emphasis on thoroughness and the overall patient experience.

"Joining a practice that places such a strong emphasis on the patient experience was important to me," said Dr. Calvin Kundi. "The team at Dentistry First shares a commitment to thoroughness and to making patients feel genuinely comfortable, and that is the environment I was looking for."

Dentistry First operates according to six guiding clinical principles established at its founding: respecting patient needs, excellence in diagnosis, precision and thoroughness in treatment, minimum intervention, prevention over intervention, and continuous education. The practice uses digital radiography and advanced imaging technology to support accurate diagnosis and treatment planning across all service areas.

The clinic holds QIP dental practice accreditation and maintains affiliations with several major health fund networks as a preferred provider. It also participates in the Medicare Child Dental Benefits Scheme and provides services under the Australian Government Department of Veterans Affairs programme, ensuring accessible care for a broad cross-section of the community.

The practice recently surpassed 100 five-star reviews on Google, a milestone the clinic attributes to its team-centred culture and consistent focus on patient communication and clinical outcomes across both

routine and complex cases.

Dr. Kundi's appointment is the second significant development at Dentistry First in recent months, following the completion of a Master of Clinical Dentistry in Fixed and Removable Prosthodontics by Principal Dentist Dr. Jason Phan. Together, these developments reflect a deliberate expansion of the practice's clinical depth and its capacity to manage a broader range of patient needs locally.

The practice is co-led by Dr. Jason Phan and Dr. Jen Phan, both graduates of the University of Queensland who established Dentistry First on the Sunshine Coast following careers in regional Queensland. Dr. Jen Phan leads the clinic's paediatric dentistry services, while Dr. Nadia Qin, a University of Queensland honours graduate with a background in regional communities, rounds out a clinical team that now spans general, restorative, cosmetic, paediatric, and prosthodontic disciplines.
