



InstallMySigns Identifies Key Operational Hurdles in Commercial Real Estate Sign Project Management

InstallMySigns has examined the recurring operational difficulties that commercial real estate teams encounter when coordinating signage projects across multiple properties, installers, and regulatory environments. The platform, which connects commercial real estate offices directly with local sign installers, organizes orders, communications, and tracking in a single dashboard and has supported more than 35,000 orders for major firms since its development more than two decades ago.

Commercial real estate professionals routinely manage sign requests amid competing priorities involving listings, brokers, and vendors. Traditional approaches often rely on scattered email threads, spreadsheets, and separate online forms, which can lead to delayed updates, inconsistent artwork tracking, and overlooked deadlines. InstallMySigns consolidates these elements so that offices and installers maintain visibility into each stage of a project from initial request through installation.

Bob Chapa, CEO and President of InstallMySigns, observed that fragmented processes create friction at scale. "Over time, teams managing sign orders across different markets encounter unnecessary confusion when tools remain disconnected," Chapa said. "Centralized visibility into orders, approvals, and schedules

helps keep projects moving consistently through each phase.?

One frequent area of difficulty involves communication. Requests and status updates often pass through multiple inboxes involving brokers, marketing staff, designers, and installers. Without a shared record, details can be missed and timelines extended. The platform addresses this through a centralized communication hub that keeps project messages, files, and images in one location accessible to the relevant parties.

Visibility into project status represents another common challenge. Manual tracking systems require ongoing updates and follow-up calls or messages. InstallMySigns provides real-time reporting through dashboards that display order stages, allowing both commercial real estate offices and installers to filter by location, installer, or broker and receive notifications of changes.

Artwork proofing and approval processes frequently introduce delays. Revisions related to branding, listing details, or specifications can generate extended back-and-forth exchanges. The platform enables users to upload designs, review comments, and record approvals within the system, creating a historical record of revisions that supports future projects.

Compliance with local regulations adds further complexity. Sign size limits, placement rules, and permitting requirements differ by municipality and can change. InstallMySigns incorporates a city sign code database and permit tracking module so that teams can reference applicable standards and maintain records of compliance for each project.

Record-keeping and reporting also affect operations. Without complete documentation of order dates, approvals, installation photos, and invoices, teams may lack ready information for internal reviews or to resolve questions. The platform stores these records for ongoing reference and supports billing and payment history tracking.

Chapa noted the cumulative effect of these issues. ?As portfolios expand and projects span multiple jurisdictions, structured workflows become more important for maintaining coordination between real estate offices and local installers,? he said. ?Features such as automated workflows, photo galleries, scheduling tools, and mobile access help reduce the gaps that arise from disconnected methods.?

InstallMySigns was originally developed more than 20 years ago to address organizational and tracking needs for a local sign company in Detroit. It has since been made available more broadly as a subscription-based system that supports unlimited projects, clients, and installers. Core capabilities include 60-second ordering options, instant chat, Google Maps integration, service area mapping, installer checklists, and marketing tools. The system is accessible via desktop and mobile applications and emphasizes direct connections between commercial real estate offices and their chosen local installers rather than intermediary

layers.

The platform supports both commercial real estate offices seeking control over listings and sign installers managing multiple client projects. Installers gain organized views of assigned work, status alerts, and digital documentation of designs, permits, and completed installations. Real estate teams gain transparency across brokers and properties while maintaining direct lines of communication.

In an environment where physical signage continues to contribute to property visibility, the ability to manage orders efficiently supports broader operational goals. InstallMySigns focuses on providing the tools for order tracking, compliance reference, proofing, and documentation that commercial real estate professionals and installers use in daily practice.
