



Voytec Decorator Ltd Strengthens Focus on Microcement Bathrooms and Waterproof Interior Installations Across West Yorkshire

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Voytec Decorator Ltd has announced a strengthened focus on specialist microcement installations across its West Yorkshire service area, reflecting growing demand for seamless waterproof finishes in residential renovation projects. The Shipley-based decorative finishing company said it is placing greater emphasis on microcement bathrooms, walk-in showers, kitchens, floors and other waterproof interior applications while continuing to offer Venetian plaster, painting and wallpaper installation as part of its specialist interior finishing services.

The development forms part of the company's long-term direction as it responds to changing renovation trends and increasing interest in seamless decorative surfaces. Rather than expanding into new product categories, Voytec Decorator Ltd is increasing the availability of specialist microcement installations throughout the locations it serves, enabling homeowners, architects, interior designers and property professionals to access decorative waterproof finishes delivered by experienced specialist applicators.

Across West Yorkshire, homeowners are increasingly investing in renovation projects that prioritise both design continuity and practical performance. Bathrooms, in particular, have become a central focus, with many renovation plans moving away from traditional tiled finishes in favour of seamless waterproof surfaces. Kitchens, utility rooms and open-plan living areas have also contributed to growing interest in decorative finishes that create visual consistency across multiple spaces within the same property.

Voytec Decorator Ltd said that this shift has resulted in a growing proportion of enquiries relating to microcement bathrooms, walk-in showers and seamless interior surfaces. The company has therefore chosen to place greater emphasis on these specialist applications throughout its service area.

Microcement is applied in multiple thin layers over carefully prepared substrates before being sealed to produce a continuous decorative finish. The material can be installed across walls, floors and fitted surfaces, creating a seamless appearance that has become increasingly popular in modern bathrooms and kitchens. Because successful installation depends heavily on substrate preparation, moisture management and application techniques, specialist installation has become an important consideration for property owners undertaking renovation work.

Bathrooms remain one of the strongest areas of demand for the company. Homeowners renovating existing bathrooms are increasingly exploring alternatives to conventional tiled walls and floors, particularly where they wish to create contemporary spaces with minimal visual interruption. Walk-in showers have also become a significant area of interest, as seamless waterproof finishes can extend across multiple surfaces to create a cohesive design throughout the room.

Microcement flooring has also become a more frequent part of residential renovation projects. Rather than limiting decorative finishes to individual rooms, many homeowners are selecting continuous flooring that connects kitchens, dining spaces and living areas. This approach allows different parts of a property to share a consistent visual character while complementing wider architectural and interior design schemes.

Kitchen renovations have contributed to the growing use of specialist microcement installations as well. Decorative finishes are increasingly being specified for splashbacks, islands, worktops and surrounding wall surfaces, enabling homeowners to coordinate these areas with adjoining living spaces. By integrating decorative surface selection into the early stages of renovation planning, clients are often able to achieve greater continuity throughout the finished interior.

Voytec Decorator Ltd explained that careful planning remains fundamental to every microcement project.

Before installation begins, each property is assessed to determine substrate suitability, existing surface condition and project requirements. Discussions also cover colour selection, texture, finish options and how the decorative surfaces will integrate with other stages of the renovation, helping to coordinate work involving plumbers, electricians, joiners and other specialist trades.

Commenting on the company's renewed direction, Wojciech Wasilewski, owner of Voytec Decorator Ltd, said, "Microcement has become an increasingly important part of the projects we complete throughout West Yorkshire. More homeowners are planning seamless bathrooms, walk-in showers, kitchens and living spaces as part of complete renovations, and these projects require careful preparation and specialist application. By placing greater emphasis on microcement installations across the areas we serve, we can continue supporting clients with the technical planning and decorative expertise these interiors require."

The company noted that the renewed emphasis reflects broader developments within residential design rather than a short-term trend. Property owners are increasingly approaching renovation projects as complete interior transformations, with decorative surface finishes considered during the planning stages instead of being selected after construction work has already begun. This approach enables waterproof finishes, flooring and wall surfaces to be coordinated with lighting, cabinetry, sanitaryware and architectural details to create more cohesive interiors.

Architects and interior designers have also contributed to growing awareness of seamless decorative finishes through projects that prioritise clean lines, open layouts and consistent material palettes. While each renovation differs according to the property and the client's objectives, microcement has become one of several decorative materials used to support these contemporary design approaches across residential interiors.

Although microcement now represents the company's primary focus, Voytec Decorator Ltd continues to provide a broader range of specialist decorative finishes. Venetian plaster remains available for feature walls, reception areas and other decorative interior spaces where handcrafted textured finishes are required, while painting and wallpaper installation continue to support complete refurbishment projects.
