



Deck Builder Expands Construction Services to Watertown

NEWTON, MA - September 24, 2026 -

All Pro Newton Deck Builders has expanded its deck design and construction services to Watertown, Massachusetts, extending an established residential building operation to homeowners throughout the Middlesex County community. The expansion makes custom deck planning, municipal permitting support, and installation available to Watertown property owners who previously arranged comparable work through contractors based outside the area.

The move responds to sustained demand for outdoor living projects across the greater Boston region, where homeowners have directed spending toward decks, porches, and other exterior additions in recent years. Watertown, positioned along the Charles River and bordering Newton and Cambridge, contains a mix of older single-family homes and multifamily properties, many of which involve renovation and outdoor-space projects suited to custom deck work. National industry data has shown that outdoor living additions rank among the residential improvements that most consistently return a share of their cost at resale.

"The expansion gives Watertown homeowners local access to custom deck design and code-compliant construction," said John Greene, owner of All Pro Newton Deck Builders. "The goal is to shorten the distance

between a homeowner and a contractor who already understands the permitting requirements in this part of the state."

Deck construction in Massachusetts is governed by the state building code and requires local permitting, structural review, and adherence to footing, ledger, and setback specifications that are enforced at the municipal level. The expansion into Watertown includes coordination with the local building department on permit applications, plan review, and inspection scheduling, steps that are completed as part of each project rather than left to the property owner. That coordination matters because deck failures are frequently traced to improper ledger attachment or footing depth, conditions that permitting and inspection are designed to prevent.

The services now available in Watertown span design consultation, material selection, and construction using pressure-treated lumber, cedar, and composite decking, together with related features such as railings, stairs, lighting, and built-in seating. The company also performs the repair and replacement of aging structures, which building officials commonly identify as a safety concern once fasteners, support posts, or ledger boards deteriorate. Homeowners seeking custom deck work in the area can review project details on the company website.

Material choices influence both cost and maintenance over the life of a deck. Composite decking, introduced widely in the late 1990s, has gained share because it resists rot and requires less frequent sealing than natural wood, while cedar and pressure-treated lumber remain common where lower upfront cost is a priority. Consultations in Watertown include a review of these trade-offs alongside the structural framing, which is built from pressure-treated lumber regardless of the surface material selected.

Older decks represent a meaningful portion of the work anticipated in the newly served area, since many were built decades ago under earlier code provisions and predate current fastening and flashing standards. Replacement projects typically address rot where a deck meets the house, corroded hardware, and railings that no longer meet height and load requirements. Addressing those elements brings a structure into compliance and reduces the risk of collapse under occupied loads.

"Every project begins with the permitting and structural requirements that a municipality enforces, and the work follows those standards from footing to final inspection," said Greene. He added that clear documentation of permits and inspections also assists homeowners at the point of sale, when buyers and their inspectors examine whether exterior structures were built to code.

The expansion reflects a broader pattern in which residential contractors extend into adjacent municipalities as outdoor renovation demand spreads across metropolitan areas. For Watertown, the arrival of a dedicated deck contractor adds local capacity in a segment that requires specialized structural knowledge and

familiarity with municipal permitting practices. The company has indicated that service in the community is active and that consultations for new and replacement projects are being scheduled.
