



Go Industries Expands Winch Grille Guards Line With Heavy Duty Commercial Grade Systems

Go Industries Inc has expanded its front end protection lineup with the introduction of a commercial grade integrated winch system built on a modular grille guard platform. The new offering broadens the range of options available to truck owners, fleet operators, and off-road enthusiasts seeking durable front end protection combined with winch mounting capability.

The Commercial Grade Winch System features a modular design that serves as the base for adding a winch carrier and brush guards. Each unit is constructed from 5/16 laser cut steel uprights paired with 2.5 inch, 16 gauge steel cross tubes. The system arrives with custom mounting brackets engineered for strength and designed with the installer in mind. Optional 9.5 or 16.5 winch carriers are available, along with optional brush guards that follow the vehicle lines and add protection to the headlight area from road debris and off-road brush.

The expanded line reflects continued demand for heavy duty winch grille guards among operators who

require both protection and functionality in demanding conditions. The systems are backed by a three year warranty covering materials, workmanship, and finish, and parts are manufactured in the United States.

"The expansion of this line responds to what the market has been telling the company for some time," said a spokesperson for Go Industries. "Operators in commercial and off-road settings need front end protection that can accommodate a winch without compromising strength, and the modular approach allows each system to be tailored to the year, make, and model of the vehicle."

The modular format allows customers to configure a system to match specific needs, selecting brush guards and winch carriers as required. The design is compatible with a range of vehicle applications and can be finished in multiple color options. As part of the company's front end protection and winch application categories, the system joins an existing catalog that includes Rancher Grille Guards, BigTex Grille Guards, and medium duty grille guards.

"Domestic manufacturing remains central to how the company operates," the spokesperson added. "Producing parts in the United States gives the team direct oversight of quality and consistency, which matters most when the product is engineered to withstand real impact and heavy use."

Beyond front end protection, Go Industries manufactures a broad selection of truck accessories. The company produces heavy duty headache racks for trucks, along with air flow tailgates, flat iron headache racks, mud flaps, steps, and Pro Series bumper replacements. Grille guards, bumper replacements, and headache racks produced by the company are made in the United States.
