

Noova Stone Launches Expanded Custom Surface Line for Residential and Commercial Applications

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Noova Stone Custom Countertops has formally introduced its expanded catalog of engineered quartz, natural granite, and marble surface offerings. The updated product lineup expands the fabricator's material availability for residential remodels and commercial buildouts across Bristol County, introducing new slab dimensions, edge profiles, and specialized surface treatments.

The rollout addresses specific material performance standards required for high-traffic food preparation areas. The updated catalog includes non-porous engineered quartz slabs designed for high stain resistance and low liquid absorption, as well as high-density granite and marble selections treated with sealant applications to protect against thermal shock and surface scratching.

The collection offers slabs in standard 2-centimeter and 3-centimeter thicknesses to accommodate varying cabinet weight capacities and structural layouts. Homeowners and contractors can select from several surface finishes, including traditional full-gloss polish, low-reflection honed textures, and tactile leathered finishes.

To support custom layout requirements, the line includes precision edge-profiling options ranging from standard eased and bevel edges to complex bullnose, ogee, and mitered waterfall drops. Every installation from the new inventory includes material coverage, with engineered quartz slabs supported by a 10-year manufacturer warranty against structural defects.

In addition to slab distribution, Noova Stone has implemented digital layout software that allows clients to preview slab vein matching and seam placement prior to fabrication. This digital tooling reduces pattern misalignment on larger installations, such as kitchen islands and full-height stone backsplashes.

To substantiate its environmental practices, Noova Stone requires its primary quartz material suppliers to hold GREENGUARD Gold Certification, verifying that the indoor surfaces meet strict chemical emissions limits. The manufacturing process utilizes closed-loop water recycling systems during the wet-cutting, routing,

and edge-polishing stages. This filtration system reclaims and filters industrial process water, reducing total gallon usage per slab cut and minimizing runoff waste. Natural stone materials in the collection, including granite and marble, are sourced from suppliers adhering to international environmental management standards (ISO 14001) for responsible quarrying and land restoration.

Coinciding with the expansion, Noova Stone has published a suite of technical care guides designed to assist property owners in selecting and maintaining natural and engineered stone. The documentation outlines long-term care protocols, including:

Sealing Frequency: Care schedules detailing sealant reapplication timelines for natural marble and granite based on usage density.

Chemical Compatibility: Guidance on pH-neutral cleaning agents to prevent surface etching on calcite-based stones like marble.

Heat Management: Specific thermal tolerances across different material compositions to prevent thermal shock fractures.

These operational guides are publicly accessible via the company's online resource portal to help buyers evaluate long-term maintenance commitments before finalizing material orders.

The complete inventory of new surface options is available for viewing at the company's regional showroom facility. Design consultations, physical slab inspections, and project estimating services are currently open for scheduled appointments.
