Learning Tree Academy Offers Drop-In Care Option at Wood-Ridge Location

WOOD-RIDGE, NJ - August 11, 2026 -

Learning Tree Academy now provides a drop-in daycare option at the Wood-Ridge location for children ages 18 months to 5 years. The service offers short-term care without requiring a full-time enrollment commitment.

Families may use the drop-in program for appointments, errands, or other temporary needs. Advanced reservation is required, and space is limited. An enrollment packet must be completed in advance, and children must meet the academy's health and immunization requirements before attending.

Drop-in participants experience the same Creative Curriculum approach used in the academy's full-time programs. Children engage in play-based activities in inviting classrooms that support learning, creativity, and social interaction with peers. Experienced teachers provide individualized attention during each session and maintain the same daily routines and structure familiar to regularly enrolled children.

Nataliya Malinovsky, Owner, said, "The drop-in care option allows families to access the same quality environment and experienced teachers for shorter periods when full-time enrollment is not needed."

Half-day and full-day options are available to match varying schedules. The program operates within the academy's established safety framework, which includes 24/7 video surveillance, a secure entry system, and controlled access. These measures remain in place for all children, including those using drop-in services.

The Wood-Ridge facility also offers infant care from six weeks to 18 months, toddler programs for ages 18 months to three years, and preschool classrooms for ages three to five. The Creative Curriculum supports development across social-emotional, physical, cognitive, and language domains through intentional play and exploration. Teachers adapt activities to the interests and developmental levels of the children present each day. The Positive Discipline approach guides daily interactions to encourage respect, problem-solving, cooperation, and personal responsibility.

The academy partners with the Carlstadt School District for the universal pre-kindergarten program. Before- and after-school care is available for participating students and is expanding to accommodate children from additional districts. Parents arrange transportation for Carlstadt students.

The academy serves families from Wood-Ridge and nearby communities in Bergen, Hudson, and Passaic Counties through its full range of early childhood programs. Drop-in care is available as a flexible option within that broader service. Enrollment for full-time programs proceeds on a rolling basis based on availability. A 10 percent sibling discount applies to eligible enrollments. Families provide meals and snacks according to nutrition and allergy guidelines.

Malinovsky continued, "Providing drop-in care extends the academy's ability to support families who need reliable short-term options while maintaining consistent standards of care and supervision."

Teachers at the academy bring experience working with children across age groups and participate in ongoing professional development to stay aligned with current early childhood practices. Regular communication practices help keep families informed during both full-time and drop-in stays. The familiar classroom environment allows children to settle quickly into activities and routines, reducing transition stress for both children and parents.

The drop-in program complements the academy's year-round offerings by addressing occasional care needs without altering the core educational approach. Children participate in the same play-based experiences and receive the same level of attention from staff. This consistency helps maintain a sense of security and engagement even during short visits.

Safety and health protocols remain consistent across all programs. In addition to surveillance and secure entry, the facility uses commercial-grade UV air purification systems. Staff follows established procedures for hygiene, supervision ratios, and emergency preparedness at all times.

Learning Tree Academy provides early childhood care and education in Wood-Ridge, New Jersey. The academy offers infant, toddler, and preschool programs along with before and after school care, summer camp, and drop-in options. Programs emphasize play-based learning and whole-child development in a supportive setting.

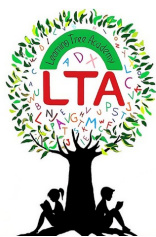
