the rest of the residence. The crew utilizes heavy-duty plastic sheeting to seal off the designated work area. The company completely covers air ventilation registers within the construction zone to prevent microscopic particulate matter from circulating.

To further control airborne particulates, the firm continuously operates specialized air scrubbing equipment on the job site. These industrial devices actively pull airborne dust out of the atmosphere within the contained workspace. In addition to air quality control, the company installs heavy-duty floor protection materials over existing hardwood floors. The crew also covers tile and carpeted surfaces along primary walkways. This preventative measure guards against scratches caused by heavy foot traffic while preventing impact damage from falling debris during the heavy demolition phases.

True Pillar Design & Build approaches full-home renovations by addressing underlying architectural challenges holistically. The company coordinates structural systems to ensure seamless integration across the entire property. When selecting materials, the firm emphasizes long-term durability. The procurement process incorporates solid wood cabinetry and natural stone countertops. The designers also prioritize moisture-resistant flooring for high-traffic zones. The material selection process extends to mechanical fixtures. Internal drawer glides and door hinges undergo significant mechanical stress during daily use, prompting the company to source heavy-duty components for these specific applications.
