



Post Electric Expands Industrial Electrician Services Across Southwest Missouri

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Post Electric, an employee-owned electrical contractor with more than 15 years of service in Southwest Missouri, has formally expanded its industrial electrical division to support the growing operational needs of manufacturing plants, agricultural facilities, warehouses, and processing operations throughout the region. The expanded offerings address the increasing complexity of equipment found in modern industrial settings and the demand for maintenance programs that reduce unplanned downtime.

The expanded division centers on high-voltage distribution systems, transformer installation and maintenance, switchgear and disconnect installations, and power factor correction. Each of these services is designed and installed in compliance with National Electrical Code and Occupational Safety and Health Administration standards, reflecting the safety requirements associated with high-power industrial environments.

Beyond distribution systems, the work of a Post Electric Industrial Electrician now covers motor control center

installation, variable frequency drive wiring, PLC panel wiring, and machinery and conveyor electrical connections. These capabilities are aimed at facilities operating complex, automated, and continuously running equipment where precise electrical work is essential to production.

The division also includes industrial lighting solutions, such as LED high-bay fixtures, explosion-proof lighting for hazardous locations, and exterior security lighting. Preventive maintenance programs featuring thermographic inspections and component testing form another component of the expansion, providing facilities with early detection of potential failures before they interrupt operations.

"The expansion reflects what the region's industrial operators have been asking for," said Ryan, Master Electrician at Post Electric. "Facilities running motor control centers, variable frequency drives, and high-voltage distribution need a contractor who understands both the equipment and the code requirements that govern it. The goal is to keep production running safely and to catch issues before they become shutdowns."

The company employs a Master Electrician on staff and has completed more than 500 projects across residential, commercial, and industrial sectors. The industrial expansion draws on that project history while adding equipment upgrades, staff training, and diagnostic technology intended to improve the accuracy and speed of service.

As part of the announcement, Post Electric confirmed that its 24-hour emergency industrial response service remains available to facilities requiring urgent attention. Unplanned electrical failures in industrial environments can halt entire production lines, and the emergency service is structured to address those situations at any hour.

"Preventive maintenance and emergency response work together," Ryan added. "Thermographic inspections and component testing identify weak points during scheduled visits, and the emergency team handles anything that cannot wait. Both are built around minimizing downtime for the facilities that depend on us."

The employee-owned company is licensed and insured, and it applies current techniques and quality materials to residential, commercial, and industrial projects alike.
