The most visible function of a metal supplier is stock. Hot-rolled steel is commonly used for structural work and general fabrication. Cold-rolled steel is often selected when a smoother finish and tighter tolerances are needed. Galvanized steel is suited for outdoor and corrosion-prone environments, while stainless steel is widely used in food processing, medical, and industrial applications.

RBI National Metals also provides alloy steel and tool steel among its available metal varieties. Non-ferrous inventory includes aluminum, copper, brass, and bronze, chosen for corrosion resistance, conductivity, lightweight, or machinability, depending on the job. Since sizes, grades, and specifications can vary within each category, buyers should confirm the project's requirements before placing an order.

Another function of a metal supplier is helping buyers understand material grades, specifications, and processing requirements. Different grades and alloys can have distinct performance characteristics, making the intended application an important factor in material selection. For stainless steel, for example, factors such as corrosion exposure, fabrication requirements, and project specifications can influence which grade is appropriate.

Sourcing is a related service for projects that require materials not available in a supplier's standard inventory. When a required grade, dimension, quantity, or certification falls outside standard inventory, the material may need to be specially sourced.

Processing services can also be part of a metal supplier's role, depending on the supplier and project requirements. The metal supplier in Riverside County lists band saw, shear, laser, waterjet, and plasma cutting among its available services, with the processing method depending on factors such as material type, thickness, and project requirements.

Forming work covers bending, hole punching, precision drilling, structural forming, and custom fabrication built to submitted measurements. Finishing and assembly extend further still, into welding, powder coating, and surface finishing. RBI National Metals can also provide processing before delivery, allowing material to arrive closer to the dimensions and specifications required for fabrication or installation.

Timing can also influence how materials and processing services are coordinated. Availability may differ by material, grade, quantity, and processing requirements, so buyers should discuss expected lead times when requesting a quote. When cutting, drilling, coating, or other processing is completed before delivery, it may also reduce the number of separate fabrication steps that need to be coordinated afterward.

Providing detailed project information can make the quoting process clearer. Dimensions, quantities, tolerances, finish requirements, and the conditions the finished part will operate in all affect which material and which processing method may be appropriate for a particular application.

Some projects may also require material certifications or other documentation. Those requirements should be identified before an order is placed so the supplier can determine whether the requested materials and documentation are available. Providing drawings, sketches, dimensions, or written specifications can further clarify the material and processing requirements being quoted. RBI National Metals states that material options with specific certification requirements are available depending on project specifications.
