

Henderson School Launches STEM, Arts and Digital Learning Programs

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Henderson International School, a private educational institution, has announced a new initiative that adds science and technology coursework, an expanded arts program, and a digital learning platform for students across its grade levels.

The school said the initiative will be introduced in stages over the coming academic year rather than launched at once. Administrators said the phased approach allows the school to adjust each component based on how students respond before the next stage begins.

The science, technology, engineering and mathematics component is the largest piece of the initiative, according to the school. It includes laboratory coursework, project-based assignments and planned partnerships with professionals working in related fields. School officials said the partnerships are intended to give students exposure to how the subject matter is applied outside the classroom.

The arts program will run alongside the science coursework and includes workshops, visiting artist sessions and scheduled opportunities for students to present work through exhibitions and performances. Administrators said the arts component was developed at the same time as the science program rather than added afterward, and that scheduling was structured so students are not required to choose between the two.

The digital learning platform gives students access to course materials outside of school hours and allows instructors to adjust assignments based on individual progress. School officials said the platform is meant to supplement classroom instruction rather than replace it. Administrators said teachers will use platform data to identify where individual students need additional support.

Officials said the initiative was developed over the previous academic year with input from department heads and teaching staff. Administrators said the planning process included reviewing which existing courses would be affected by the new programming and how instructional time would be allocated. The school said some scheduling adjustments were required to accommodate the added coursework without extending the school

day.

Faculty training is part of the rollout as well, according to the school. Administrators said instructors involved in the science and arts components will complete preparation sessions before each stage begins, and that training related to the digital platform is being handled separately. Officials said the training schedule was set to avoid overlapping with instructional periods.

School officials said the initiative also reflects ongoing attention to enrollment diversity and faculty recruitment. Administrators said the school continues to work on recruiting and retaining teaching staff from a range of backgrounds, and that curriculum planning for the new programs took student population differences into account.

Support services will continue alongside the new programs, according to the school. These include academic advising and student wellness resources, which administrators said are coordinated with classroom instruction rather than operating separately. Officials said the school reviews these services at regular intervals as student needs change.

The initiative comes as families evaluating private schools in Henderson, NV weigh factors including academic programming, technology access and extracurricular offerings. School officials said questions from prospective families about technology and project-based learning have become more frequent in recent admissions cycles, which informed how the initiative was structured.

Administrators said the school plans to gather feedback from students, families and faculty as each stage of the initiative is introduced. Officials said adjustments will be made based on that feedback rather than on a predetermined schedule, and that some components may be expanded or scaled back depending on results.

The school said additional details about individual program components will be released as each stage begins. Officials said timelines for the later stages have not been finalized and will depend in part on how the earlier components are received.
