The new resource explains that artificial turf can provide another option when landscape plans call for consistent ground coverage without the watering, mowing, and seasonal upkeep commonly associated with natural grass. Selecting the appropriate application, however, begins with understanding how the surrounding property is used.

The publication emphasizes that artificial turf installation involves more than placing synthetic material over an existing surface. Proper site preparation is an important part of the process and can influence drainage, stability, and the finished appearance. Existing vegetation may need to be removed, and the underlying area must be evaluated before installation proceeds. Grading and base preparation also require attention so the completed surface integrates appropriately with nearby walkways, planting areas, structures, and other landscape features.

Design considerations receive particular attention in the resource. Residential yards, commercial properties, gathering spaces, and other outdoor areas can have different traffic patterns and functional requirements. A landscape design should account for how people move through the property, where outdoor furniture or other features may be located, and how synthetic turf will connect visually with existing elements. Thoughtful planning helps artificial grass become part of a cohesive landscape rather than an isolated addition.

The guide also examines the relationship between artificial turf and broader landscape development. Synthetic grass can be incorporated alongside planted beds, hardscape areas, decorative features, and other outdoor improvements. Balancing these elements allows property owners to preserve visual variety while developing spaces suited to local conditions. For commercial sites, planning may also include considerations involving entrances, high-traffic areas, visibility, and the appearance of exterior spaces throughout the year.

Ongoing care is another topic covered in the publication. Although artificial turf does not require the same maintenance routine as natural grass, periodic attention can help preserve its appearance. Removing debris, monitoring heavily used areas, and addressing changes around edges or adjoining landscape features can remain part of regular property maintenance. Understanding those responsibilities before installation helps owners develop realistic expectations about long-term care.
