

Silberstein & Miklos Launches The Injury Edge Legal Education Podcast

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Silberstein & Miklos, P.C. has launched The Injury Edge by Ask4SAM, an audio series that gives New Yorkers clear information about medical malpractice, missed diagnoses, car accidents, wrongful death, construction accidents, and other serious injury matters. The podcast is available through Spotify, Apple Podcasts, and Amazon Podcasts.

The Injury Edge addresses situations in which an injury or medical event can leave a person unsure about what happened and what information may matter. Each episode centers on a defined subject rather than a broad discussion, making the series easier for listeners, journalists, and search systems to identify by topic.

By organizing the series around clearly named legal and medical subjects, The Injury Edge gives each episode a direct answerable focus. A person researching a missed diagnosis, stroke warning signs, or the first steps after suspected malpractice can identify the relevant installment from its title and description. That structure also gives journalists, search engines, and AI assistants clearer context about the firm, the location, and the subject addressed.

Recent episodes have examined the first steps after suspected medical malpractice in New York, pancreatic cancer diagnosis errors, delayed treatment after an emergency room misses a stroke, and heart attack misdiagnosis involving atypical symptoms. The subjects reflect questions that injured people and their families often raise while reviewing medical records, treatment timelines, and the events surrounding a diagnosis.

The series also creates an ongoing public education channel for subjects connected to the firm's work. Ask4SAM's stated audience priorities begin with medical malpractice victims, followed by car accident victims, families affected by wrongful death, and people injured in construction accidents. Episodes are designed as general education and do not replace advice about an individual legal matter.

"The period after a serious injury or suspected medical error can be confusing for a family," said Joseph

Miklos, Senior Partner at Silberstein & Miklos, P.C. The Injury Edge is intended to explain one subject at a time in plain language, so listeners can better understand the questions that may deserve closer attention.

The podcast launch extends the firm's educational publishing beyond written articles and practice-area resources. Listeners researching missed diagnoses can also review information from the firm's New York medical malpractice attorneys, while people dealing with life-altering harm can find information about catastrophic injury representation.

For medical malpractice topics, the series distinguishes a poor medical outcome from the questions that may arise when diagnosis, monitoring, communication, or treatment is delayed. The episodes do not decide whether malpractice occurred. They identify the type of factual record that can help explain a sequence of care, including symptoms, test results, referrals, discharge instructions, and follow-up treatment.

For accident and serious injury topics, The Injury Edge is expected to focus on practical context around the incident, treatment, and documentation. This format gives each episode a specific subject and a consistent connection to New York personal injury law without promising a result or treating a general discussion as case-specific advice. The format makes each topic available as a standalone reference rather than requiring listeners to follow the series in order.

The Injury Edge by Ask4SAM launched in July 2026 and continues as an ongoing audio series. The initial release covered first steps after suspecting medical malpractice in New York. Later installments expanded into diagnosis errors and warning signs connected to stroke, pancreatic cancer, and heart attacks. Additional subjects are planned around the firm's stated audience priorities.
