



Christian Community Homes & Services Earns Five-Star CMS Rating for Quality Care

Christian Community Homes & Services has received a five-star overall rating from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services for its skilled nursing facility at the Hudson campus. The designation, part of the federal Five-Star Quality Rating System, reflects performance in health inspections, staffing levels, and quality measures.

The CMS rating system evaluates Medicare- and Medicaid-certified nursing homes nationwide to help families and consumers compare facilities. Christian Community Home in Hudson achieved the highest overall rating of five stars, with five-star scores in both quality measures and staffing. The health inspection component received a three-star rating. Staffing data indicate nursing time of approximately 4.24 hours per resident per day, exceeding the national average.

This recognition aligns with the organization's long-standing focus on delivering consistent, resident-centered care. The Hudson campus skilled nursing program, known as Willow Glen, provides long-term care and transitional care and rehabilitation services. Residents receive individualized care plans developed in collaboration with physicians, families, and clinical teams, addressing complex medical needs

while supporting functional abilities and personal preferences.

Shelly DeStasio, Director of Community Relations, commented on the achievement. "The five-star CMS rating reflects the daily commitment of our nursing, therapy, and support teams to high standards of care and resident well-being. It validates the systems and culture we have built to serve seniors effectively."

Christian Community Homes & Services operates as a nonprofit, faith-based organization offering a continuum of senior living options. The Hudson campus includes Willow Glen skilled nursing and rehabilitation, Pine Ridge assisted living, Pine Ridge Gardens secure memory care, and WinterGreen independent senior apartments. The Osceola campus provides skilled nursing, transitional care and rehabilitation, and assisted living, with a covered link to the Osceola Medical Center for convenient medical access.

Founded in 1981 through the efforts of the Hudson United Methodist Church and local community supporters, the organization began as a single skilled nursing facility and has expanded to meet evolving senior care needs. Its mission centers on nurturing graceful living rooted in faith, with services that honor the uniqueness of each resident. Spiritual care, including weekly church services and pastoral support, is integrated alongside clinical, recreational, and dietary programs.

The Christian Community Campus Foundation supports these efforts by funding resident assistance, equipment, staff education through scholarships, and life enrichment activities. Employee development initiatives, including recognition programs and educational support, contribute to staffing stability and expertise that underpin quality outcomes measured by CMS.

The five-star rating provides an external benchmark of performance in areas that matter to families selecting care options. Quality measures track clinical outcomes and resident status, while staffing ratings assess the availability of nursing personnel relative to resident needs. Facilities with five-star overall ratings are considered to perform much above average by CMS standards.

Christian Community Homes & Services continues to emphasize collaboration, continuous improvement, and adherence to its core values of integrity, accountability, respect, compassion, and humor. These principles guide operations across both campuses and inform decisions about care delivery, facility enhancements, and team support.

As demand for skilled nursing and rehabilitation services grows with demographic shifts in the region, the organization maintains its focus on measurable quality and personalized service. The CMS designation offers families an additional data point when evaluating options for short-term recovery or long-term care.

The recognition builds on the organization's history of community partnership and commitment to seniors. Through consistent application of clinical standards, adequate staffing, and attention to quality indicators, Christian Community Homes & Services demonstrates its capacity to meet federal performance expectations while upholding a faith-based, resident-focused approach.
