Technicians apply biodegradable pre-treatments designed for commercial soils before performing the extraction. Stubborn spots such as coffee, ink, or grease receive targeted treatment. After extraction, the

carpet is groomed to restore pile appearance and support faster drying. Services can be scheduled during off-hours to minimize disruption to daily operations.
