Field crews perform source-separation on jobsites to segregate recyclable materials including structural steel, copper piping, untreated lumber, clean concrete, and masonry

Diverting salvageable building products from regional landfills aligns with Connecticut's comprehensive materials management goals, reducing overall disposal volume while enabling concrete processing for reusable aggregate base on subsequent civil construction projects.

To assist property owners, general contractors, and commercial developers evaluating site preparation options, AAA Advantage Carting & Demolition updated its public digital documentation library. The online platform provides open access to educational materials regarding local demolition permit procedures, utility disconnect timelines, hazardous material abatement overview requirements, and structural deconstruction methods.
