

Phillips Heating and Air Conditioning Expands Regional Infrastructure to Meet Rising Cooling Demands

The systems also meet updated federal seasonal energy efficiency ratio standards established for northern climate zones, ensuring full compliance with current regional energy and environmental regulatory frameworks.
