The update provides information about personal injury matters, documentation, insurance issues, and the role of legal counsel when a civil claim is being evaluated.

"Personal injury matters often involve several sources of information that must be reviewed before the legal issues can be assessed," said Brian Mittman, Esq., managing partner of The Disability Guys. "The firm's role is to examine the circumstances, explain the applicable process, and identify the legal issues presented by the available records."

Personal injury law addresses civil claims arising from incidents in which an individual alleges harm resulting from another party's conduct. These matters can include vehicle collisions, pedestrian incidents,

premises-related accidents, construction accidents, dog bites, medical malpractice claims, and other injury circumstances. The Disability Guys maintains information about injury and disability matters handled by attorneys associated with the firm.

The legal review of an injury claim generally begins with the circumstances surrounding the incident and the records available to document what occurred. Attorneys may examine accident reports, photographs, medical records, witness information, insurance correspondence, employment records, and other materials relevant to liability and claimed damages. The type of evidence involved varies according to the facts of each matter and the legal theories under consideration.

New York personal injury cases are also subject to procedural requirements and filing deadlines. The applicable deadline can depend on the type of claim, the parties involved, and other circumstances established by law. Claims involving a private individual or business can follow different procedures from matters involving a municipality, public authority, or other governmental entity, making early identification of the parties an important part of case review.

Insurance issues can form another part of the personal injury process. An incident may involve automobile coverage, property insurance, business liability coverage, workers' compensation benefits, or multiple forms of coverage depending on the circumstances. Attorneys reviewing a matter can examine available policies and communications to determine which legal and administrative processes may apply.

Vehicle-related injury matters can involve questions concerning how a collision occurred, the insurance policies associated with the vehicles, medical documentation, and the relationship between an injury and the reported event. New York also has insurance rules that affect claims arising from motor vehicle accidents. The specific legal path depends on the facts and documentation associated with an individual incident.

Premises-related matters involve a different factual analysis. These claims can require examination of property conditions, maintenance records, incident reports, photographs, surveillance materials, and notice of an alleged hazard. The identity of the property owner, tenant, contractor, management company, or other responsible party can also affect how a claim is evaluated.

Work-related accidents may involve both workers' compensation and separate personal injury issues. The Disability Guys has historically handled workers' compensation, Social Security disability, and injury-related matters, and managing partner Brian Mittman has represented injured workers and their families since 1994. An incident occurring during employment can require an examination of the worker's employment relationship, the location of the incident, the parties involved, and whether a party other than the employer may have legal responsibility.

Medical documentation is another component commonly reviewed in injury cases. Records can establish the timing of treatment, diagnoses, procedures, work restrictions, and other information relevant to the claimed injury. Attorneys may compare those records with incident documentation and other evidence when assessing the factual basis of a civil claim.

The firm's updated personal injury information also addresses the distinction between evaluating a potential case and determining the eventual outcome of a legal proceeding. An attorney's review can identify applicable statutes, potential parties, procedural deadlines, and available evidence, but the resolution of a matter depends on its individual facts, applicable law, negotiations, court rulings, and other case-specific developments.
