This approach to daylight harvesting is an operational tactic utilized by some commercial property managers aiming to manage electrical

consumption. Routine professional cleaning is also utilized to monitor the proliferation of exterior mold, algae, and mildew around window casings, addressing concerns about moisture or biological elements potentially affecting the building envelope.
