Identifying issues during seasonal maintenance can help property owners plan for necessary repairs or adjustments before irrigation demand returns the following year.

“The end of the irrigation season is a good opportunity to identify smaller problems before they turn into larger ones,” the Heritage Irrigation spokesperson added. “When technicians are already evaluating the system for winterization, they can identify items that may need attention before spring startup.”
