



Canadian Winter Travelers Increasingly Choose Morocco for Warm-Weather Cultural Escapes Beyond Traditional Sun Destinations

Canadian travelers seeking warm-weather destinations for the fall and winter months have increasingly turned their attention to Morocco, where the combination of mild winter temperatures, direct flight connections from Montreal and Toronto, and a favorable exchange rate has made the North African country an attractive option for those looking to escape the colder months. Morocco Countryside Tours, a Marrakech-based tour operator led by local Berber guides, reports rising interest from North American travelers looking for private, guided experiences beyond the standard group tour circuit.

"We have seen a noticeable increase in inquiries from Canadian and American travelers over the past two travel seasons, particularly from people who want a more personal experience than what large group tours offer," said a company representative at Morocco Countryside Tours. "They are not just looking for a place with good weather. They want to understand the culture, meet local people, and see places that are not in

every travel blog. Morocco offers that combination of accessible international travel and deep cultural richness that many travelers are seeking right now."

Morocco welcomed a record 17.4 million visitors in 2024, according to the Ministry of Tourism, surpassing pre-pandemic levels and marking the country's highest annual visitor numbers on record. Tourism revenue reached 112 billion Moroccan dirhams in 2024, reflecting sustained growth in the sector. The 2030 FIFA World Cup, which Morocco will co-host with Spain and Portugal, has accelerated infrastructure investment including expanded airport capacity, new high-speed rail connections, and hotel development across multiple cities, improvements that are expected to benefit the travel experience for visitors in the years ahead.

The tourism trend toward private and small-group cultural travel has been particularly beneficial for local operators who can offer tailored experiences. Morocco Countryside Tours specializes in private desert expeditions, mountain trekking in the Atlas range, and guided visits through the historic medinas of Marrakech and Fes, all led by guides born and raised in the regions they show visitors. The company's private Morocco tours are designed for travelers who prefer customized itineraries over fixed group schedules, allowing for flexibility in pacing, interests, and travel style.

According to the United Nations World Tourism Organization, international tourist arrivals in Africa reached 96 percent of pre-pandemic levels in 2024, with North Africa performing particularly strongly. Morocco's proximity to Europe, expanding airlift capacity from North American airports, and investments in tourism infrastructure have positioned it as a leading destination on the continent. The country's diverse geography, ranging from Atlantic coastlines and mountain ranges to the Sahara Desert, gives it broad appeal across different travel preferences and seasons.

"Winter is actually an excellent time to visit Morocco because the desert and mountain temperatures are comfortable for daytime exploration, and the cities are less crowded than during the peak summer season," the company representative noted. "Many travelers from Canada discover that Morocco offers a genuinely distinctive winter escape that combines elements they cannot find in the typical sun destinations. The cultural component adds a layer of depth that makes the trip memorable beyond just the weather."

Morocco Countryside Tours' Sahara expeditions include multi-day desert journeys with overnight stays in traditional desert camps, camel treks across the Erg Chebbi dunes, and visits to remote Berber villages in the Atlas Mountains. All tours are private and customizable, with English-speaking guides and support from local communities throughout the itinerary. The company operates year-round, with autumn and spring offering particularly favorable conditions for extended travel across the country's varied terrain.
