



Bootin & Savrick Pediatric Associates Reveals Poll Findings on What Houston Parents Value in Pediatricians

Among respondents, 46.3 percent identified a doctor who listens and communicates well as the single most important consideration. Strong experience and reputation followed at 26.9 percent, while insurance coverage and overall affordability accounted for 17.9 percent. Convenient appointment availability and a location close to home each drew 4.5 percent of responses.

The results point to a growing emphasis on relationship-based care at a time when many families report rushed appointments and inconsistent follow-up. The data suggests that parents increasingly prioritize clear

conversation and continuity over factors such as proximity or scheduling convenience.

"These findings reflect what many families have expressed for years," said Dr. Debra Bootin, co-founder of Bootin & Savrick Pediatric Associates. "Parents want a physician who takes the time to listen, explains matters clearly, and remains a consistent presence throughout a child's development. The poll confirms that communication is not a secondary concern but a central one."
