



Crusaders Fence Expands Service Focus as Project Volume Climbs

CULPEPER, VA - August 31, 2026 -

The Fredericksburg region is not one jurisdiction but many, a city ringed by a half-dozen counties that each write their own rules on how tall a fence can stand and how far back from a property line it has to sit. Crusaders Fence, a licensed and insured fence installation company based in Culpeper, VA, has named that region its primary service focus for the rest of 2026, after the share of its installations there grew by more than 60 percent this year.

That patchwork is the practical reason a contractor gains by working one area closely. Crusaders Fence files the permits, handles homeowners association submissions where a neighborhood requires approval, and coordinates VA811 utility marking, the state service that locates buried gas, water and electric lines before any digging begins. A plan cleared in one county can come back needing changes a few miles away, and knowing where those lines fall before a homeowner does is most of what the concentration buys.

The company opened in 2025 and holds Virginia contractor license number 2705197740, with founder Conall Finn drawing on more than 10 years in the trade.

Wood and vinyl privacy fencing draw the largest share of residential requests across the area. Most wood jobs are privacy styles at four, five or six feet, among them board-on-board and shadowbox layouts that stagger the pickets on alternating sides of the rails so the fence reads as finished from both yards. Pressure-treated pine is still the common choice, though Finn has fielded steadily more questions about cedar, which weathers to a soft gray rather than the greenish cast treated pine can take on. Vinyl privacy, almost always in white, now runs slightly ahead of wood.

Aluminum goes up mostly around pools, where Virginia's barrier rules call for a minimum height of 48 inches and a gate that latches and swings shut on its own so a child cannot pull it open. Chain link and ranch-style fencing fill out much of the rest. Repair work runs steadily alongside the new installs, most of it posts that have heaved or gates that have dropped out of square after a wet season, and the company takes on light commercial jobs as well.

Grouping jobs inside a tighter radius has pulled lead times down, since crews spend less of the day driving between sites. Every project still starts with a walk of the property before a number is quoted, which is where grade changes and disagreements over where a line actually runs tend to surface. Homeowners get a written estimate on that first visit, itemized line by line, and most residential fences go in within one to two days.

The move has weighted the map rather than narrowed it. Crusaders Fence still works Culpeper, Fauquier, Orange and the other Central Virginia counties it has served since opening.

"People call us with a style already in mind, and the first real conversation is about what their county will actually allow." Finn, who has set fence line across Central Virginia for more than a decade, said the map is the part homeowners tend to underestimate. "Work one area closely and you learn where those answers change from one town to the next. That saves a customer more grief than anything I could tell them about our craftsmanship."
