

Satolah Creek Farm Announces Unique Farm Stays for Eco-Tourism Enthusiasts

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Satolah Creek Farm has announced the introduction of a new farm stay program, providing overnight accommodations and opportunities for visitors to experience aspects of daily life on an agricultural property. The program is now available at the farm in Rabun County, Georgia, and was developed by founders David and Amanda Reynolds as a new addition to the property's visitor offerings.
