



Jump Around Party Rentals Launches Fall Festival Rental Hub for Greater Austin

Round Rock, Texas - August 25, 2026 -

Jump Around Party Rentals, a Greater Austin party and event rental company operating since 2008, has launched a dedicated fall festival rental planning resource consolidating equipment information, planning guidance, and booking access for churches, schools, HOAs, and corporate event teams across Travis, Williamson, and Bell counties.

The page addresses a common logistical challenge for fall event coordinators: managing multiple vendors across bounce houses, rides, games, food equipment, and seating. Jump Around Party Rentals operates a single-vendor model in which one crew delivers, sets up, and tears down the full event footprint.

"October weekends in Greater Austin are some of the most competitive rental dates of the year," said William Gann, owner of Jump Around Party Rentals. "Based on our booking history, October Saturdays typically fill six to eight weeks out. Church carnivals, school fundraisers, and HOA fall nights all want the same dates. We built this page so event coordinators have one place to plan their lineup and start the booking process early enough to lock their date."

The fall festival rental lineup includes inflatable bounce houses and combo units, obstacle courses, a trackless train, dunk tanks, carnival game booths, inflatable carnival games, concession machines, party tents, and table and chair packages. For events serving teen and adult guests, the mechanical bull, rock climbing wall, and bungee trampoline are also available.

Jump Around Party Rentals carries liability insurance and submits its amusement ride equipment for annual safety inspection as required under the Texas Amusement Ride Safety Inspection and Insurance Act, administered by the Texas Department of Insurance. Certificates of Insurance are available on request at no additional cost. School-district vendor approval documentation is provided through the company's standard booking process.

The new resource includes a six-step fall festival planning guide covering booking timelines, crowd-flow calculations, venue logistics, age-range attraction planning, insurance documentation, and concession revenue strategy.

The six-step planning guide on the page walks event coordinators through the full preparation process in the order decisions actually need to be made. It opens with booking lead times, noting that October Saturdays in Central Texas are among the most competitive rental dates of the year and that locking a date with a deposit while the attraction list is still being finalized is standard practice rather than an exception. From there, the guide addresses crowd-flow planning - specifically how many attractions need to run simultaneously for a given guest count - using one attraction per 50 guests as a baseline and adjusting for age mix and event length. A section on venue logistics covers surface types, electrical access requirements, gate clearance minimums, and how the company handles asphalt anchoring when ground stakes are not an option.

The guide closes with two sections that event coordinators running fundraiser-oriented festivals often find most actionable. The insurance and documentation section outlines the typical two-to-four-week approval window that school districts and church campuses require before an event date, and explains what the Certificate of Insurance provided by Jump Around Party Rentals includes. The concession revenue section presents the case that ticket-based snow cone and cotton candy sales frequently offset a meaningful portion of total rental costs, making concession machine rentals one of the higher-return line items in a festival budget.
