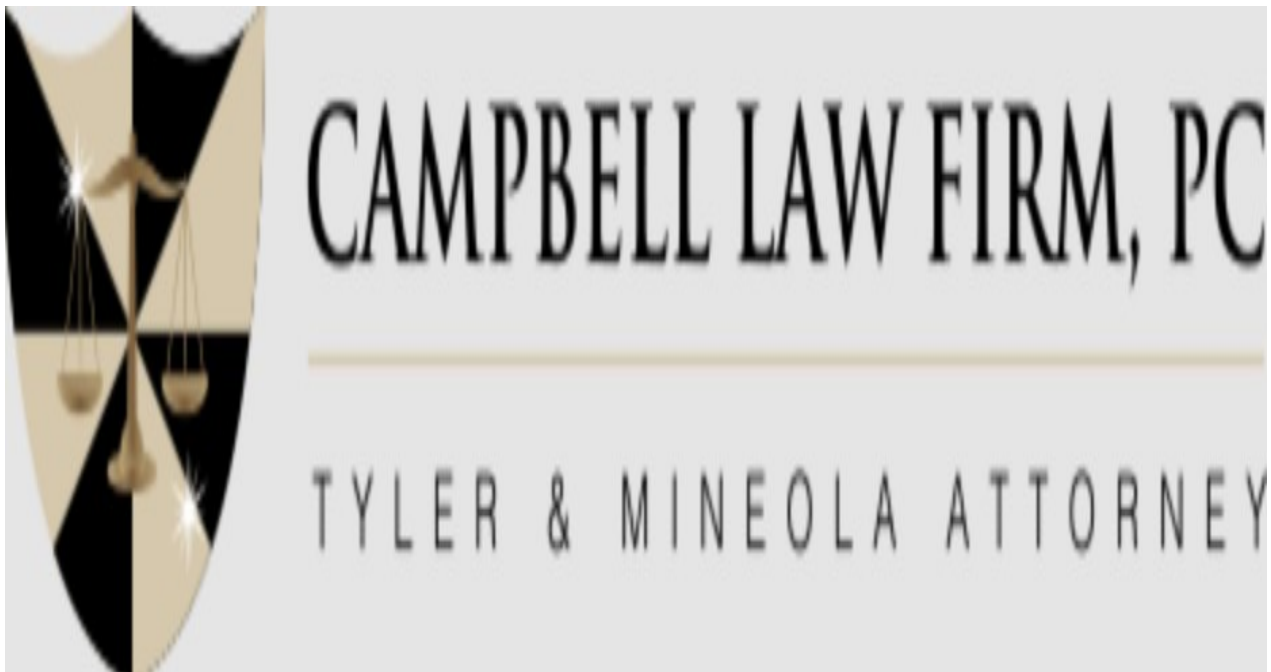




Trust Attorney in Mineola Highlights the Value of Proactive Estate Planning

Long-term care is another issue that may warrant advance consideration. The potential cost of nursing home care can raise concerns about preserving assets and preparing for future needs, but the availability and effectiveness of legal planning strategies depend on a person's circumstances, the timing of planning, and applicable state and federal law. Certain asset-protection or benefit-planning strategies may involve eligibility rules, transfer restrictions, or other legal requirements. Those considerations make individualized legal guidance important when evaluating available options.
