To support the expanded service scope, Barrington Smiles has integrated updated clinical technology and specialized practitioner training. Dr. Milad Saad completed post-graduate continuing education coursework focusing on full-arch implant-supported restorations using the LOCATOR Fixed[®] system, which secures full-arch prostheses directly to dental implants.

Unlike traditional removable overdentures that rely primarily on mucosal suction or temporary adhesives, implant-supported systems offer distinct biomechanical characteristics, though clinical outcomes depend on individual patient anatomy and health history:

Appliance stability: Anchorage to strategically placed dental implants is engineered to minimize

micro-movement, helping reduce appliance displacement during speech and mastication compared to conventional removable plates. Alveolar bone support: Dental implant posts provide mechanical stimulation to the jawbone, which may help slow the rate of natural bone resorption that commonly occurs following tooth extraction. Streamlined protocols: Systems like LOCATOR Fixed allow existing implant abutments to be utilized for fixed or semi-fixed restorations, offering streamlined conversion pathways for clinically eligible candidates.

Barrington Smiles incorporates 3D digital imaging and diagnostic mapping into its prosthetic treatment planning workflows. The practice utilizes high-resolution digital intraoral scans to capture anatomical details of hard and soft oral tissues, replacing traditional physical impression materials for many procedural steps.

Supported by state-licensed Registered Dental Hygienists (RDHs), the clinical team conducts comprehensive oral evaluations prior to prosthetic placement. Diagnostic protocols assess periodontium health, temporomandibular joint (TMJ) alignment, and facial tissue support. Patient candidacy for implant-supported restorations requires a thorough clinical examination, 3D bone density assessment, and medical history review, as individual anatomical and systemic health factors dictate treatment viability.
