Michael Turner, M.D. Introduces Broader Access to Testosterone-Related Medical Services

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KENNEWICK, WA - August 26, 2026 -

Michael Turner, M.D., announced the availability of physician-led testosterone services for individuals across additional service areas, marking an operational expansion of access to hormone-related medical care within his outpatient practice.
