

Sigma Air Announces Expanded HVAC Technician Team Amid Seasonal Cooling Demand

The federal agency also identifies regular maintenance and appropriate equipment sizing as important considerations when operating residential HVAC systems.

The technician expansion is separate from any specific equipment manufacturer and applies to the company's broader HVAC operations. Sigma Air said the additional staffing will allow its existing team structure to accommodate installation and service requests while maintaining its current scheduling and operational procedures.

The company is also using the expansion to reinforce the importance of evaluating existing equipment before replacement. Age, repair history, system condition, and changes to a property can all be relevant when determining whether an existing air conditioning system should be repaired, replaced, or otherwise evaluated.

As part of its current communications, Sigma Air is providing information about AC installation in San Antonio and related HVAC considerations through its website. The company said the material is intended to give property owners a clearer understanding of installation and maintenance topics without replacing an evaluation by a qualified HVAC professional.

The company's latest operational update reflects its preparation for the current cooling season and its continued focus on staffing across its HVAC service activities. The expanded team is expected to support the company's existing installation, maintenance, and repair operations as seasonal demand develops.
