The addition gives patients another option for addressing certain alignment and bite concerns without using traditional metal brackets and wires.

Orthodontic treatment has changed considerably over the past several decades. Traditional fixed braces remain a common and effective approach for many types of orthodontic correction, particularly when more complex tooth movement is required. Clear aligners, meanwhile, have become an alternative for patients who may be candidates for removable orthodontic appliances. The appropriate treatment depends on factors such as a patient's dental anatomy, bite, oral health, and treatment goals.

Invisalign treatment uses a series of custom-made, clear thermoplastic aligners designed to gradually move the teeth. Treatment generally begins with a digital scan of the patient's mouth. The scan provides three-dimensional images that can be used to develop a treatment plan and map out the anticipated movement of the teeth throughout treatment. Once the aligners are produced, the patient wears them in a prescribed sequence, typically changing to a new set every one to two weeks. The exact schedule and overall treatment length vary depending on the individual case.

For patients exploring Invisalign in Shorewood, WI, one of the main differences between clear aligners and traditional braces is that the aligners are removable. Patients can take the aligners out when eating and drinking, which means they generally do not face the same food restrictions associated with fixed brackets and wires. Foods that are hard, sticky, or chewy can sometimes damage or dislodge traditional orthodontic appliances, whereas patients using removable aligners can take them out before meals.

Clear aligners also allow patients to maintain their usual brushing and flossing routine more easily. With fixed braces, patients need to clean carefully around brackets, wires, and other orthodontic components. Patients wearing clear aligners remove the trays before brushing and flossing, allowing them to clean their teeth and gums without working around fixed hardware. The aligners themselves also need to be cleaned regularly and

worn according to the dental provider's instructions.

The material used for clear aligners is smooth and designed to fit closely over the teeth. Some patients may experience temporary pressure, tenderness, or minor irritation when beginning a new set, particularly as the teeth adjust to the planned movement. As with any orthodontic appliance, individual experiences can vary.

Digital treatment planning is another component of clear aligner therapy. Using scans and specialized software, the dental team can evaluate the patient's current alignment and plan a series of incremental movements. This information can help determine whether clear aligners are a reasonable treatment option. In some cases, traditional braces or another orthodontic approach may be more appropriate.
