



## **World of Wonder Childcare Center Opens Fall Enrollment Across Three Centers**

World of Wonder Childcare Center has opened fall enrollment at all three of its centers serving families in Hoboken and Jersey City. The organization offers programs for children from infancy through Intermediate Pre-K and maintains a consistent bilingual English and Spanish environment at every location.

Enrollment is available for both full-time and part-time schedules, subject to current classroom capacity. Families may select any of the three centers, each of which follows the same curriculum framework and daily structure. Children progress through infant, pre-toddler, toddler, and Intermediate Pre-K stages while encountering both languages through routines, songs, conversations, mealtimes, and play. The shared approach allows children to experience continuity in language exposure and developmental expectations as they advance from one age group to the next.

Diane Branco, CEO, stated, "We have opened enrollment for the fall at every location so that families can secure a place while space remains. The bilingual approach is part of the daily experience at all three centers, giving children consistent exposure to English and Spanish from the start."

The centers operate year-round and observe only a limited number of holiday closures. These scheduled breaks are intentional and allow educators time to rest so they can return prepared to provide attentive, patient care. By limiting extended interruptions, the organization supports working families who need reliable access to care throughout the calendar year while also protecting staff well-being. Full-time and part-time options remain available according to capacity at each site, giving families flexibility within the consistent program structure.

Parent feedback published on the organization's website includes accounts from families whose children began in the infant room and later advanced to older classrooms. One such family described strong communication from teachers and a growing sense of connection among parents outside regular care hours. These observations align with the center's stated emphasis on relationships between staff, children, and families that extend beyond the classroom day.

Branco added, "Enrollment is open now at all three centers. We recommend that interested families begin the process soon so we can match children with the appropriate classroom and schedule before available spots are filled."

World of Wonder Childcare Center focuses exclusively on the early childhood years rather than broader age ranges. This specialization enables educators to concentrate on the specific developmental needs of infants and young children as they move through successive stages. Language exposure occurs naturally within the flow of the day rather than as a separate instructional block. Both English and Spanish are present during circle time, transitions, outdoor play, and quiet moments, reflecting the linguistic diversity of the communities the centers serve and supporting early communication skills.

By opening fall enrollment across the full network of three centers, the organization provides families with clear access to its programs while maintaining consistent standards at each site. Educators prepare classrooms and daily routines to welcome both new and returning children, preserving the same focus on secure relationships, language development, and community connections. The structure supports continuity for children who remain with the organization over multiple years and offers parents reliable options in both Hoboken and Jersey City.

The three-center model ensures that families encounter the same bilingual environment and developmental progression regardless of which location they choose. Children experience aligned expectations and language practices as they grow, which helps create a stable foundation during the early years. Enrollment remains open at present, allowing families to explore available classrooms and schedules while space continues to exist.

World of Wonder Childcare Center provides bilingual early childhood programs for infants through Intermediate Pre-K at three centers in Hoboken at 401 Jackson Street and Jersey City at 133 Harrison Street and 319 Johnston Ave. The organization emphasizes consistent daily practices, natural language exposure from infancy, and supportive relationships that help families remain connected during the early years.
