



CollaVita Collagen Announces Temporary Packaging Update and Scoop Removal as Waste Reduction Measure

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CollaVita Collagen has removed the plastic scoop from its current production batch of collagen peptides as part of a waste-reduction initiative. The change applies only to the batch now shipping, and the scoop is scheduled to return in the next production run.

While the scoop is absent, the company advises customers to measure servings using a standard tablespoon. Each serving of CollaVita Collagen Peptides equals two tablespoons, which allows customers to portion the product accurately without the included scoop.

The company emphasized that the packaging adjustment affects only the scoop and does not alter the product formulation, sourcing, or manufacturing standards. The collagen peptides in the current batch remain identical to prior batches in composition and quality.

"The decision to remove the scoop from this batch came down to reducing unnecessary plastic waste, and it reflects an operational priority that guides how we evaluate our packaging," said Enes Demirel, general manager of CollaVita Collagen. "Keeping customers informed matters to us, so the recommendation to use a standard tablespoon for each two-tablespoon serving is being communicated clearly. The scoop will return with the next production run."

The adjustment is a single-batch measure rather than a permanent change to the product line. Customers who receive a container without a scoop during this period can continue to use the product as they normally would, substituting a household tablespoon for measurement.

CollaVita Collagen maintains manufacturing and quality standards across its production, and the current batch continues to be third-party lab tested and produced under GMP-compliant processes. The company holds multiple ISO certifications, including 9001, 14001, and 45001, reflecting its approach to product purity, environmental responsibility, and workplace safety. The company's collagen peptides are also supported by Halal, Kosher, and GMO-Free certifications, addressing a range of dietary and lifestyle needs.

The environmental consideration behind the scoop removal aligns with the company's broader attention to packaging materials and waste. The company noted that evaluating small changes, such as the removal of a single plastic component from a batch, forms part of its ongoing review of operational practices.

The scoop is expected to be reinstated in subsequent production, at which point containers will ship with the standard measuring tool included. Until then, the tablespoon guidance remains the company's recommended method for portioning each serving.
