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Brooms Over Broome Announces Free Recurring Cleanings for Local Humane Society

Brooms Over Broome will begin providing recurring professional cleaning services at no charge to a local Humane Society in September 2026. The arrangement is intended to support a cleaner and more comfortable environment for the animals, staff, volunteers, and community members served by the organization.

The company will apply its regular residential and commercial cleaning methods to the Humane Society on an ongoing schedule. Recurring service is designed to maintain consistent conditions rather than address the space only once. That approach allows the shelter's staff and volunteers to keep attention on animal care, adoptions, and related programs instead of diverting time to facility upkeep.

Debbie Godbay, owner of Brooms Over Broome, said the decision grew out of long-standing ties to the surrounding community. "Our community has supported Brooms Over Broome for many years, and we're always looking for meaningful ways to give back. Providing recurring cleanings for our local Humane Society is one way we can use what we do best to support an organization doing such important work in our community," Godbay said.

Humane Society operations typically involve high-traffic public areas, animal housing spaces, and workrooms used daily by employees and volunteers. Regular professional cleaning can help those areas remain orderly and presentable for visitors considering adoption as well as for the people who work there. The donated service will follow the same standards the company uses for other recurring accounts, including trained personnel and established cleaning systems.

Godbay also pointed to the daily demands placed on shelter teams. "The Humane Society's team and volunteers dedicate so much time and care to helping animals in need. We're proud to support their mission by helping provide a clean and welcoming space so they can stay focused on the incredible work they do every day," she said.

Brooms Over Broome has offered recurring house cleaning, deep cleaning, window washing, student housing upkeep, move-in and move-out service, and commercial cleaning since 1994. Recurring work is a core part of the company's model, with schedules set to match client needs and checklists used to keep results consistent from visit to visit. Applying that same structure to a community organization is an extension of existing operations rather than a separate line of work.

The company was founded after a newspaper advertisement placed by two friends and later developed into a locally owned team serving homes and businesses across the Triple Cities and the wider Broome County area. Its stated values include trust, commitment, productivity, respect, and quality. Team members are trained and background-checked, and the business reports more than 100,000 cleanings completed, more than 30 years of operation, hundreds of recurring accounts, and more than 100 five-star reviews.

Community-focused work has been part of the company's public description of itself for years. The September start of donated recurring cleanings places that stated focus into a specific, ongoing commitment. Because the service is scheduled rather than limited to a single visit, the Humane Society can plan around regular maintenance instead of arranging one-time help when conditions become difficult to manage.

The donated cleanings do not change the company's ordinary service offerings to households and businesses. Those clients continue to receive the same range of scheduled and specialty work the company has provided for more than three decades. The Humane Society project sits alongside that work as a no-charge recurring account beginning this month.

Brooms Over Broome remains a family-oriented cleaning company based in the Triple Cities region. The new arrangement reflects an effort to apply established cleaning practices to a local animal-welfare organization that depends on community support to carry out its daily mission.
