



College Fund Landscaping Outlines Scheduling Systems Used for Fall Service Accountability

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College Fund Landscaping is detailing the scheduling and documentation systems it uses to manage fall lawn care and landscaping visits. The Plano landscaping company, founded in 1996 by Matt Davis, says those tools are intended to confirm when crews arrive, record completed work, and keep customers informed as seasonal maintenance continues.

The company states on its website that it operates with fixed service days backed by GPS and tracking software so crews can be expected on a set schedule. Office staff handle calls, texts, and emails and communicate about upcoming visits. Quotes are provided by phone or email, often within 24 hours, and the first scheduled service is described as occurring within seven days of confirmation.

"We pride ourselves on timely, accurate communication, and we show up when we say we're going to show up," said Matt, Owner.

Davis said the same systems also record staff time and document each property visit. According to the owner, employees clock in and clock out through company software, GPS records when crews are at a

house, and photographs are taken of each property serviced. The company describes that process as part of a broader effort to keep operations consistent and documented rather than informal.

“We’ve got GPS software on all of our employees clock in, they clock out. We know exactly when you’re at the house. We take pictures of every house. We’re very systemized, and we document all those things,” said Matt, Owner.

Those procedures sit alongside licensing and training claims published by the company. College Fund Landscaping identifies itself as a TDA- and TECQ-licensed applicator. TDA refers to the Texas Department of Agriculture, which licenses pesticide applicators who apply lawn and landscape treatments. TECQ, as written on the company website, corresponds to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, commonly abbreviated TCEQ, which issues certain occupational licenses in Texas. The company also states that its workforce is legally background checked, licensed, and insured, and that team members complete ongoing continuing education.

The company further lists a 100 percent satisfaction guarantee backed by what it calls an Easy Resolution Warranty. Under that policy, if a customer is not satisfied, the company says it will return to address the issue. If the matter is still unresolved, the customer may adjust payment to reflect the level of satisfaction, including paying nothing.

College Fund Landscaping reports more than 600 online reviews and cites multiple “Best Of” awards on its website, without naming the issuing publications or years. The business also notes nearly three decades of operation and a family-owned structure. Those figures are company-stated and are not independently itemized on the site.

Fall work covered by the same operating system includes fertilization, weed control, mowing, tree and shrub care, landscaping installations, mulch and rock work, leaf removal, and seasonal cleanups. The company serves residential properties in its North Texas service area and continues community programs that include an annual client scholarship raffle, a scholarship contribution to the University of North Texas Business School, and a food drive supporting the North Texas Food Bank.

Davis started the business as a high school student to help pay for college. That origin remains part of the company’s public identity, while current operations rely on scheduled routing, time tracking, property photographs, and office communication to coordinate service visits.

College Fund Landscaping provides lawn care, landscaping, and tree and shrub services and uses

GPS-backed scheduling and visit documentation as part of its published operating model.
