



Macho Contracting Marks 10 Years of Specialized Plumbing Services

To support its ongoing service operations across residential and commercial sectors, the firm has updated its field equipment and broadened its daily technician dispatch capacity for subterranean utility management. Throughout its decade in business, the organization has provided localized maintenance, pipe repairs, and comprehensive system management, including specialized work on private septic systems and lift stations Scottsdale, AZ property owners and municipal systems utilize. The company's service adjustments reflect a focused approach to maintaining aging subterranean pipe infrastructure and managing the specific soil factors that impact underground wastewater networks in arid environments. During this operational milestone, the firm continues to prioritize safety and structural longevity for new construction plumbing and existing system retrofits.

The technical operations of Macho Contracting are structured around strict industry licensing and professional credentials. Company literature cites over 25 years of combined wastewater and plumbing experience across its organizational leadership and technical team. To maintain legal authorization for commercial and residential contracting in Arizona, the business holds three active licenses issued by the

Arizona Registrar of Contractors: AZ ROC 308505, AZ ROC 306109, and AZ ROC 334053. Field personnel also hold individual certifications from the National Association of Wastewater Technicians and participate in safety training programs that are aligned with Occupational Safety and Health Administration standards. These verifiable credentials permit the workforce to perform regulated wastewater procedures, including real estate transfer inspections under Arizona Department of Environmental Quality guidelines. Technicians also execute the design, permitting, pumping, and installation of conventional septic tanks, cesspools, drywells, leach fields, grease traps, and alternate treatment units for locations lacking municipal sewer access.

In addition to standard drain clearing, hydro jetting, and main sewer line repairs, the contractor executes complex subterranean projects that involve mechanical fluid transport. These services address structural building layouts where natural gravity flow is insufficient, requiring mechanical pumping equipment. Field personnel install, inspect, and service sewage ejectors, heavy-duty grinder pumps, and residential sump pump systems designed for flood mitigation and internal fluid routing. The firm also provides routine maintenance and mechanical repair for commercial lift stations in Scottsdale, AZ and neighboring regions, using diagnostic tools to evaluate continuous pump performance. To assist facility managers with routine system oversight, the business provides digital remote monitoring configurations, control panel evaluations, and initial system start-up testing. These administrative management services allow off-site tracking of pump performance metrics, assisting facility operators in identifying mechanical issues prior to system backups or unexpected line disruptions.

Beyond specialized wastewater and pump engineering, Macho Contracting maintains a general plumbing division handling standard indoor and outdoor fixtures. The firm's scope of work includes traditional and tankless water heater installations, water filtration and treatment system integrations, smart leak control systems, and gas line extensions or reroutes for household water heaters, interior ranges, and outdoor grills. The firm also offers formal plumbing system design and inspection services for new property developments. Corporate operating protocols specify that project estimates are provided within 48 hours of an initial site assessment. The business maintains regular office hours Monday through Friday, from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm, and services regional locations that include Phoenix, Mesa, Carefree, Cave Creek, Paradise Valley, Fountain Hills, Rio Verde, New River, and Norterra.
