

H&H Custom Decks and Timberz Launches Digital Service Platform

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Outdoor construction firm H&H Custom Decks and Timberz today announced the launch of a digital service platform designed to streamline project planning and initial consultations for residential property owners in Sandy, Utah.

The newly released software incorporates virtual consultation scheduling along with interactive three-dimensional rendering tools to assist property owners during the preliminary planning stages of deck construction. Through this online portal, clients can review potential structural layouts, evaluate physical material options, and adjust spatial dimensions prior to physical site preparation.

According to residential construction data released by the Utah Home Builders Association, demand for home outdoor expansion projects across the state increased by 14% between 2021 and 2023. Regional survey data from the Associated General Contractors of Utah indicates that local contractors, including professional deck builders in Sandy, UT, are increasingly adopting digital design platforms to address preliminary planning delays.

The software enables users to model structural modifications directly within a scaled three-dimensional environment to identify potential spatial conflicts early in the design cycle. By addressing technical adjustments before breaking ground, the system is designed to help reduce potential project delays and establish precise design specifications between construction teams and property owners.

In addition to virtual modeling, the platform integrates comprehensive documentation regarding local municipal building codes, zoning restrictions, and structural safety standards. Property owners can review regional structural requirements and analyze performance differences between composite decking and traditional timber options within a single portal. The integrated database also outlines load-bearing expectations and setback rules established by local planning commissions.

The system incorporates environmental data from the National Weather Service Salt Lake City station

alongside material performance standards established by ASTM International. These metrics detail how lumber treatments and composite polymers withstand high-altitude ultraviolet degradation and freeze-thaw cycles typical of Northern Utah. Material durability ratings within the portal are calibrated against published accelerated weathering test results from independent testing laboratories.

Company representative John Henderson stated that the system was engineered to improve technical communication between clients, engineering teams, and project managers. Henderson explained that providing direct access to rendered three-dimensional models clarifies architectural scope and aligns expectations before framing work begins. He noted that preliminary digital planning is intended to allow construction crews to estimate material orders with greater precision.

The virtual platform is structured to allow remote collaboration during early design phases, eliminating the immediate need for on-site preliminary consultations. Potential clients can upload property measurements, share architectural references, and receive structural feasibility feedback directly through the web interface. This digital setup enables project estimators to evaluate site parameters and provide detailed scope assessments before physical visits.

The digital resource is available immediately to regional residents planning outdoor construction projects. As established deck builders in Sandy, UT, H&H Custom Decks and Timberz will manage ongoing software updates, integrating regional code modifications and new material specifications as municipal standards evolve. Future software revisions are scheduled to include additional interactive utilities for material cost modeling.

The software deployment reflects a broader shift toward digitizing pre-construction administrative procedures within the residential building sector. Research published in Dodge Construction Network's 2023 SmartMarket Report indicates that mid-sized contracting firms are increasingly transitioning from paper-based estimations to digital intake software. By moving initial consultations online, H&H Custom Decks and Timberz aims to streamline internal administrative workflows and mitigate material procurement delays throughout Salt Lake County.
