This carpet construction provides resistance to matting, soil retention, and everyday household spills, catering to property owners seeking structured interior floor

designs.

In addition to expanded textile offerings, Carpet King and Flooring has added advanced hard-surface products, including the Cascade 4001 Playa 4001 product line with PureGrain High-Def options. This luxury vinyl plank product line replicates natural wood grain visuals through high-definition digital printing and realistic surface embossing. Built with a 20 mil wear layer and a protective top coat, the Cascade 4001 Playa 4001 line delivers scratch resistance, water resistance, and dimensional stability suitable for both residential rooms and commercial spaces.

Acoustic performance in multi-story residential and commercial buildings is governed by two distinct mechanical sound transmission pathways: Airborne Sound Transmission and Impact Sound Transmission. The structural composition of the flooring assembly—combining structural subfloors, isolation underlayments, and surface materials—dictates its ability to dissipate vibrational energy. In soft-surface applications like the DreamWeaver Spectrum and Redwood 2701 Cottonwood, the open-cell structure of the polyurethane cushion beneath the carpet acts as a mass-spring-mass absorber.

To ensure that these newly available product lines perform according to technical manufacturer specifications, Carpet King and Flooring maintains rigorous site evaluation procedures. Prior to completing carpet installation in Fairfield, CT or surrounding communities, technical personnel perform objective pre-installation site assessments.
