



VETCANS Dumpster Rental Publishes Full Jacksonville-Area Pricing

JACKSONVILLE, FL - September 03, 2026 -

As Jacksonville adds more than 16,000 residents per year and national home-improvement spending nears a record, the veteran-founded local hauler's new site lists flat rates for Duval, Clay, Nassau and St. Johns counties, with tonnage and final pickup included.

VETCANS Dumpster Rental has published its complete county-by-county pricing and a free guide library at vetcans.com, giving Northeast Florida homeowners flat, transparent roll-off rates before they book. Most people rent a dumpster only a handful of times in their life, and the price they see rarely matches the bill they pay.

Renting a dumpster costs a national average of \$386, with most homeowners paying between \$294 and \$480, according to 2026 cost data from the home-services marketplace Angi. That figure often sits before weight overages and extra-day fees that many renters don't discover until pickup.

VETCANS Dumpster Rental, a veteran-founded, family-run roll-off dumpster company serving Jacksonville and surrounding areas, has responded by publishing its complete rate sheet online, along with a free library of guides answering the questions homeowners search before they book. The move gives anyone searching for dumpster rental Jacksonville pricing a full price breakdown before they call anyone.

The industry norm leans on advertised base rates, then adds weight overages and fees once the container is already on the driveway. VETCANS Dumpster Rental built its new site around the opposite approach. Every county the company serves has its own listed flat rate for each dumpster size, in both 7-day and 14-day terms, with the included weight allowance and the per-ton overage rate printed beside the price. Final pickup is built into the quote, and there is no added sales tax. As an example, a 10-yard, 7-day rental in Duval County is listed at \$355 with one ton of disposal included.

The published pricing arrives as homeowner spending on home improvements is projected to reach \$518 billion nationally by the end of 2026, according to the Leading Indicator of Remodeling Activity from Harvard University's Joint Center for Housing Studies.

"We put the whole rate sheet on the website because that's how we'd want to be treated," said Louis Denny, owner of VETCANS Dumpster Rental. He added that the weight allowance is built into every price and the final pickup is included. "If you ever go over on weight, the extra-ton rate is printed right there. No teaser price, no surprise at pickup."

Alongside the rate sheet, the site carries a free library of plain-English guides covering the questions Northeast Florida homeowners typically search: what size dumpster a project needs, what can and cannot go inside one, whether a permit is required in Jacksonville, driveway placement, weight limits, and how to compare quotes. The guides also touch on where construction debris ends up. Construction and demolition activity generates about 600 million tons of debris a year in the United States, more than twice the nation's municipal solid waste, according to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

"Most people only rent a dumpster a handful of times in their life, so the questions are always the same," said Denny. "What size do I need, what can go in it, do I need a permit. We wrote the answers down and put them online for free. If that saves somebody a surprise fee, even if they never rent from us, that's fine by us."

The timing tracks with regional growth. Jacksonville has passed one million residents and now ranks as the 10th-most-populous U.S. city, adding roughly 16,400 residents in a single year, the fourth-largest numeric gain in the nation, according to U.S. Census Bureau estimates. Neighboring St. Johns County is Florida's

fastest-growing county, adding roughly 11,400 residents for 3.9 percent growth in a year. Renovation, new construction and property cleanouts tend to follow that kind of population growth across Duval, Clay, Nassau and St. Johns counties alike.

Booking on the new site takes about two minutes, with pin-drop placement so drivers know exactly where to leave the container, and customers receive text updates from booking through pickup. Most deliveries go out the next day. VETCANS Dumpster Rental offers 10-, 20- and 30-yard roll-off dumpsters, along with a separate 20-yard bin for clean concrete and clean fill, and calls to the company are answered by a person rather than a queue.
