



National University in San Diego Highlights Flexible Degree Options for Local Learners

National University is drawing attention to the range of flexible, accredited degree programs available to students seeking to balance education with work and family responsibilities. As demand for adaptable learning formats continues to grow, National University in San Diego has emphasized its combination of online and on-campus study options designed to accommodate a variety of schedules and career goals.

"The intent behind offering both online and on-campus formats is to give learners genuine choice in how they pursue their education."

The institution's programs cover a wide spectrum of specializations. In Teaching and Education, offerings address areas such as Early Childhood Education, Social Emotional Learning, and Online Teaching. Business and Marketing programs include Business Administration, Data Science, and Agile Project Management. In Healthcare and Nursing, students may study Nursing, Public Health, Health Informatics, and Nurse Anesthesia Practice, among other fields.

Social Sciences and Psychology programs include Psychology, Criminal Justice Administration, Applied Behavioral Analysis, and Clinical Psychology. Within Engineering and Technology, the university provides study in Cybersecurity, Computer Science, Construction Management, and Technology Management. Additional programs in Arts and Humanities and in Criminal Justice and Public Service round out the catalog, including a Certificate in Forensic and Crime Scene Investigations.

"Fields such as cybersecurity require professionals who can think about protection from more than one angle," the spokesperson added. "Programs are structured to reflect that reality, addressing both the systems themselves and the organizational policies that surround them."

The emphasis on flexible formats responds to a broader trend in higher education, where working adults and career changers increasingly seek accredited credentials that can be earned without relocating or leaving employment. National University in San Diego serves this population through a model that pairs a physical campus with distance learning options.
