

Sunday Salon Responds to Demand for Consistent Precision Haircuts

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Sunday Salon is highlighting how its tiered stylist team is designed to deliver a consistent haircut experience from one visit to the next. The salon says a recurring scenario among clients in Mordecai and the surrounding inner-Raleigh neighborhoods, arriving after an inconsistent cut elsewhere or newly settled in the area, sits behind the emphasis.

Sunday Salon provides precision haircuts to clients throughout Mordecai and the surrounding inner-Raleigh neighborhoods. Clients can choose from Stylists and Master Stylists based on their goals, preferences, and budget. The structure is designed to keep results consistent for a client returning for a second or tenth haircut, not just the first.

The salon sees two common situations among new haircut clients: people who have recently moved to the Raleigh area and are searching for a stylist they can trust long-term, and clients looking for a fresh start after a haircut that didn't meet their expectations. Sunday Salon's tiered stylist team includes multiple experience levels and price points, providing clients with information about each stylist's experience and pricing when making an appointment.

Every stylist at Sunday Salon completes extensive education, ongoing training, and works within a collaborative team environment where sharing knowledge and consulting with one another is part of the culture. Master Stylists have achieved more than 10,000 hours of hands-on experience, while Stylists continue refining their craft through mentorship, advanced education, and daily experience behind the chair. Stylists across the levels participate in continuing education, mentorship, and collaboration as part of the salon's ongoing training structure.

Every first haircut appointment at Sunday Salon begins with a personalized consultation to understand each client's hair history, goals, lifestyle, and maintenance preferences. The salon says that step is often what separates a consistent result from a repeat of the same disappointment, since a stylist working from a defined tier is expected to document and follow a client's preferences on every return visit rather than relying on

memory alone.

Sunday Salon also offers silent appointments for clients who prefer a quieter experience, along with stylists trained in curly hair cutting techniques tailored to different curl patterns and textures.

"One of the most common things we hear from new clients is that they're looking for a stylist they can trust long-term, whether they've recently moved to Raleigh or are simply ready for a fresh start," said Lisa Edwards, President & Creative Director of Sunday Salon. "Our tiered stylist team gives clients options based on their goals, lifestyle, and budget, while our collaborative approach and commitment to continuing education help ensure every client feels heard, cared for, and confident in their experience."

Every stylist at Sunday Salon works within the salon's established stylist-level structure. The levels reflect differences in experience and price point rather than restricting which services a stylist can perform. The salon operates from Raleigh Iron Works and serves clients from Mordecai and other nearby Raleigh neighborhoods.

The salon's booking process asks new clients a short set of questions about their hair history before assigning a tier, rather than defaulting every new booking to the same stylist. That detail matters most for the two client types the salon says it hears from most often: someone arriving with a specific complaint about a previous cut, and someone with no local history at all who simply wants a stylist they will not need to search for again.

For clients new to Raleigh or seeking a new salon or stylist, Sunday Salon begins haircut appointments with a consultation covering hair history, preferences, goals, and maintenance considerations.
