The location of a restoration can affect its expected lifespan. A filling in a front tooth may have different demands than one in a rear tooth, while the material selected for the restoration can also influence its durability. These considerations make individual evaluation important when an existing filling has been in place for an extended period or requires attention.

Oak Creek Dental Care also emphasizes the role of everyday oral hygiene in maintaining teeth with fillings. The practice recommends brushing twice a day for two minutes and flossing once a day. Regular dental visits are another part of the practice's recommended routine, with teeth cleanings scheduled every six months with Dr. Saleki.

Patient comfort is also addressed as part of the filling process. Oak Creek Dental Care states that the treatment area is numbed during the procedure and describes the process as minimally invasive. Individual experiences can vary, but local numbing is used to support comfort during treatment. For patients who may benefit from additional relaxation, sedation dentistry is available at Oak Creek Dental Care.

Understanding the process and expected lifespan of a filling can help patients make informed decisions about restorative care. A filling that has been in place for many years may need evaluation even if the tooth does not appear to have an immediate problem. During routine visits, Dr. Saleki can examine existing dental work and determine whether continued monitoring or additional care is appropriate.
