The office handles matters involving Social Security Disability Insurance, Supplemental Security Income, long-term disability, workers' compensation, and other claims connected with a person's ability to work following an injury or disabling condition. Social Security Disability matters involve a federal administrative process administered by the Social Security Administration. Applicants submit medical, employment, and other records for review, and denied claims can proceed through reconsideration, hearings, and additional administrative or federal review depending on the circumstances. Disability lawyers working in this area evaluate records, identify procedural requirements, prepare filings, and represent claimants during stages of the administrative process.

Long-term disability matters follow a different framework because claims can arise under employer-sponsored benefit plans, private insurance policies, or plans governed by the Employee Retirement Income Security Act. Attorneys reviewing these matters examine policy provisions, medical documentation, benefit determinations, administrative records, and applicable filing deadlines. The legal framework can vary according to the type of plan and the circumstances surrounding a benefit determination.

Workers' compensation represents another component of the firm's disability-related practice. New York workers' compensation proceedings address workplace injuries and occupational conditions through a state administrative system, while disability claims under federal programs operate under separate eligibility standards and procedures. Situations involving the same injury or medical condition can therefore produce multiple legal and administrative questions that require separate filings, records, and review processes.

Mittman has practiced law for more than three decades and is admitted in New York. Firm materials identify his practice areas as workers' compensation, Social Security Disability, long-term disability, and personal injury, and identify him as Managing Partner of Markhoff & Mittman, P.C. His professional background also includes practice before federal courts and representation in administrative proceedings involving disability and workplace injury matters.
