



Reliance Cabinetry Reports Rising Demand for Kitchen Remodeling in Richmond Hill

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Reliance Cabinetry LLC is reporting a marked increase in kitchen remodeling and custom cabinetry requests across Richmond Hill and the surrounding Bryan County area, a shift the company attributes to sustained regional population growth and a steady pace of new home construction along the I-95 corridor.

The trend reflects broader changes in the local housing landscape. As more households move into the area, demand has grown on two fronts: cabinetry work for newly built homes and remodeling projects for existing homeowners choosing to update aging kitchens rather than relocate. Industry observers note that regions near major installations often experience elevated housing activity, and local sources have pointed to the proximity of Fort Stewart and Hunter Army Airfield as one factor that may be contributing to relocation patterns in the region, though confirmed figures on military-driven population movement remain limited.

According to Reliance Cabinetry, the composition of local demand has shifted noticeably over recent months. Where remodeling of established homes once made up the bulk of inquiries, new-build cabinetry work now

represents a growing share of overall project volume. This change tracks with the pace of residential construction along the interstate corridor, where new subdivisions require cabinetry designed and installed from the ground up.

"The area is changing quickly, and the pattern is visible in the mix of projects coming in," said Edward Myers, spokesperson for Reliance Cabinetry. "A few years ago, most requests involved updating kitchens in existing homes. Now there is a steady flow of new-construction work alongside the remodels, which reflects how many people are settling into Richmond Hill and the neighboring communities."

The increase in activity has also affected project timelines. As a Richmond Hill Remodeler serving a growing customer base, the company notes that lead times for design consultations and installations have lengthened compared with previous years, a pattern common in markets experiencing rapid residential growth. Homeowners planning kitchen updates are increasingly scheduling projects further in advance to accommodate the pace of demand.

Myers added that the range of requests has broadened as the population has diversified. "There is more variety in what people are looking for," he said. "Families moving from other parts of the country bring different expectations for kitchen layout and function, and that shows up in the design conversations happening across the area."

The combination of new construction and remodeling reflects a market in transition, with demand distributed across both established neighborhoods and newer developments. For companies operating in the region, the shift has meant adjusting to a wider mix of project types than in previous years.
