



Kraken Bond Introduces Xtreme Pro Fire Block Spray Foam for Gun Application

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Kraken Bond has introduced the Kraken Bond Xtreme Pro Fire Block Spray Foam, a 24-ounce gun-applied formulation developed specifically for contractors and remodeling crews who require consistent bead control across multiple job sites. The product, engineered exclusively for professional foam-gun dispensing rather than straw application, is available now through the company's online store and ships from operations based in Chantilly, Virginia.

The formulation addresses a recurring field problem. Crews that rely on straw-applied foam often contend with uneven bead control, higher material waste and cleanup issues, particularly when sealing numerous penetrations across several sites in a single day. The gun-only format is designed to give applicators steadier dispensing and tighter control over the amount of foam released.

The Xtreme Pro Fire Block Spray Foam carries a Class A fire rating under ASTM E84 and fills gaps ranging from one-quarter inch to three inches. It can be applied in temperatures between 32 and 112 degrees

Fahrenheit, and once cured it withstands temperatures from minus 40 to 194 degrees Fahrenheit. The foam fully cures within 24 hours.

After curing, the material is mold-proof and waterproof, and it can be painted over to match surrounding surfaces. The product is formulated solely for use with professional foam-gun dispensers and is not compatible with standard straw-applied methods, a distinction intended to support repeatable results in the field.

Because the product depends on a gun for dispensing, compatibility with the right equipment matters for day-to-day work. Kraken Bond offers a range of professional foam gun accessories that pair with the formulation, allowing crews to seal pipe, conduit, electrical box and framing gaps with a consistent approach from one project to the next.

The emphasis on gun application reflects a growing preference among crews handling multiple penetrations per site. Steadier dispensing reduces the trial-and-error common with straw application, and the reduction in overspray and waste can add up across a busy schedule of remodeling and construction work.

"Field consistency is where gun-applied fire-block foam earns its place," a spokesperson for Kraken Bond LLC said. "Crews moving from one penetration to the next need the same result every time, and a gun gives them the control that straw application simply cannot match across a full day of work."
