

Howlands Trailers Expands Commercial Operations With New Enclosed Trailer Line

The newly deployed trailer inventory is structured to support these utility demands by improving localized access to commercial transport equipment.

The expanded trailer series incorporates lightweight composite paneling and contoured exterior framing engineered to reduce aerodynamic drag during highway transit. Computer-modeled fluid dynamics testing indicates potential drag reductions of up to 12% under steady highway speeds, though actual fuel savings vary based on towing vehicle specifications, load weight, and driving conditions. Standard safety and structural build specifications across the lineup include heavy-duty dual-latch locking systems, integrated interior cargo tie-down tracks, and reinforced sub-frame construction.

To accommodate varying operational requirements, the equipment line includes multiple dimensional options ranging from single-axle compact haulers to tandem-axle heavy utility units. Each structural variant features weather-sealed rear ramp doors, skid-resistant interior flooring, and standardized electrical wiring harnesses compatible with modern commercial towing vehicles. These physical configurations allow regional operators to transport equipment, construction supplies, and mobile workshop gear under protected environmental conditions.

James Howland, representative of Howlands Trailers & Truck Accessories, highlighted the operational focus behind the inventory deployment. "Commercial operators and independent trade professionals require

transit equipment that protects valuable cargo while managing routine fuel overhead," stated Howland. "This operational addition provides regional businesses with immediate access to secure hauling infrastructure tailored for daily commercial routes."
