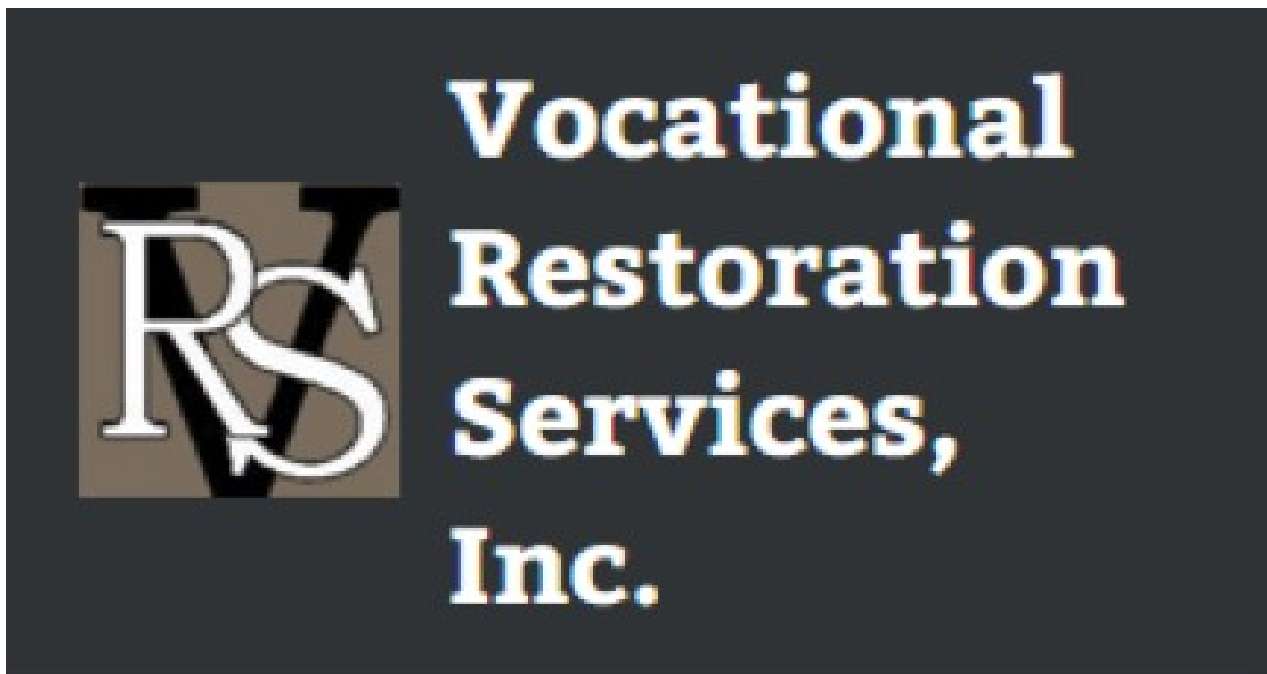




Vocational Restoration Services Inc. Offers Rehabilitation, Workers Compensation Assistance

If a worker been injured in a workplace accident, a QRC can help them recover from the trauma and get back to work -- ideally, at their old job and wage rate. Qualified Rehabilitation Consultants (QRCs) assist injured employees while they recover from workers' compensation injuries.

If an injury precludes someone from working in your previous capacity, Vocational Restoration Services can help find other employment, based on a client's restrictions, and even help with job retraining.

Vocational Restoration Services specialties include: rehabilitation consultation, medical management,

vocational counseling and guidance, job seeking skills training, job development and placement, on-site job analyses, transferable skills analyses, administration and evaluation of vocational testing, labor market surveys, develop and evaluate retraining plans, job modifications and ergonomic evaluations, coordination of return to work, and expert testimony.

A trusted QRC can be a key ally in workers compensation incidents. Vocational Restoration Services can surface and address all potential injuries to maximize a client's rehab, help them avoid pushing themselves to return to work too soon, and work with clients and their doctors to come up with creative strategies for retraining and for managing restrictions, such as reduced ability to bend or carry objects.

QRCs communicate with all parties in a workers' compensation claim, including the employee, doctors, the employer, the insurance adjuster, the insurer's attorney, and the employee's attorney if one has been retained.

The insurance company may assign injured workers a QRC, or one can choose their own vocational rehab specialist. Once the company has made its choice, one has 60 days to accept or reject the QRC.

Vocational Restoration Services highly trained nationally certified rehabilitation counselors are registered as Qualified Rehabilitation Consultants at the Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry.
