



Peace of Growth Adds Quartate as AI Implementation Partner

According to Peace of Growth, existing clients needed support automating the handling of business documents. Bringing in an implementation partner with data experience is intended to address those requirements and support future clients with similar needs. The collaboration serves U.S. service businesses, with a focus on field service companies.

"Our three-pronged approach combines AI visibility, Meta advertising and AI employee creation," said Muhammad Sarim Khan, founder of Peace of Growth. "This partnership strengthens that third prong. Our clients needed help handling the data in invoices, purchasing documents and other records. Quartate brings implementation experience in that field, helping us support those clients and future businesses with the same need."

An initial workflow will be defined with each client before implementation. Peace of Growth will establish how the requirement relates to the client's operations and growth objectives; Quartate will assess the records, systems and technical work involved. Scope, timing, review requirements and evaluation measures will be agreed for the engagement.

For a field service business, a workflow might connect information collected during a service visit with office records. Quartate's published examples include assigning details from voice notes or photographs to the relevant job and checking completed work against contracts and invoices. These illustrate possible applications; the partnership is not reporting results from completed joint deployments.

Quartate also describes checking supplier bills against orders and deliveries. The common requirement is to interpret incoming information and compare it with records the business already holds. Whether an individual process is suitable for automation depends on those records and the decisions involved.

The studio's published method includes software checks against client data, review of missing or contradictory information and human approval of irreversible actions. These controls establish where an automated step can proceed and where staff need to intervene. They form part of the implementation design rather than an assumption that AI output will always be correct.

"Data automation depends on understanding both the document and the process around it," said Farhan Ahmed Khan, founder of Quartate. "Our implementation role is to connect the client's requirement with a system that can be checked and evaluated. That means defining the task clearly and keeping human review where the business needs it."
