In addition to traditional split-system upgrades, the expansion includes multi-zone ductless mini-split solutions for historic properties or additions lacking existing ductwork, as well as dedicated indoor air quality assessments. These diagnostic procedures evaluate filtration efficiency, ventilation exchange rates, and relative humidity levels to identify mechanical factors affecting indoor environments. Furthermore, technicians conduct whole-house pressure testing to pinpoint structural duct leaks, ensuring that conditioned air is distributed effectively without unnecessary thermal loss.
