

Diversey Dental Studio Launches Tooth Extraction in Lincoln Park, IL

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Diversey Dental Studio has expanded its clinical offerings to include surgical and simple tooth extraction in Lincoln Park, IL. Led by founder Emily Johnson, DDS, the practice now offers local residents direct access to in-house surgical interventions, advanced digital diagnostic imaging, and structured post-operative care plans.

The expanded service addresses common oral health concerns, including severe dental caries, advanced periodontal disease, acute dental trauma, impacted third molars, and necessary space creation for orthodontic alignment. By integrating these procedures into general practice, the clinic provides comprehensive diagnostic evaluations, localized anesthesia administration, bone grafting, socket preservation options, and continuous post-treatment monitoring under a single, unified clinical framework.

To support diagnostic accuracy and procedure planning, the practice utilizes Cone Beam Computed Tomography (CBCT) 3D imaging alongside digital intraoral radiography. CBCT imaging generates clear, three-dimensional visualizations of jawbone density, root morphology, and adjacent critical anatomical structures, such as maxillary sinuses and inferior alveolar nerve pathways. Clinical literature demonstrates that pre-operative 3D imaging allows clinicians to map anatomical variations precisely, reducing the risk of accidental nerve impingement, sinus perforation, and root fractures during surgical removal.

For the extraction procedure itself, the practice employs atraumatic extraction techniques using specialized periotomes and micro-elevators. Unlike traditional extraction forceps that rely on gross mechanical leverage, periotomes sever the periodontal ligament fibers cleanly within the alveolar socket. Clinical studies indicate that preserving surrounding alveolar bone walls and soft tissue structures minimizes localized tissue trauma, reduces post-operative inflammation, and supports optimal healing timelines for subsequent restorative procedures, such as dental implants, partial dentures, or fixed bridges.

Patient selection and surgical safety are established through a structured pre-operative screening process. Prior to recommending a tooth extraction in Lincoln Park, IL, Dr. Johnson conducts a comprehensive health

review, evaluating systemic conditions, blood coagulation profiles, current prescription medications, and cardiovascular health factors that may influence surgical outcomes. Anesthesia protocols are tailored to individual health profiles, with options for targeted local nerve blocks and mild oral conscious sedation for patients presenting with documented dental anxiety or complex surgical needs.

"Clear clinical criteria govern when an extraction is necessary," stated Dr. Johnson, who earned her Doctor of Dental Surgery degree from the University of Illinois Chicago College of Dentistry and maintains active certifications in basic life support, advanced cardiac life support, and continuing education in oral surgery techniques. "Our primary clinical focus remains conservative tooth preservation. However, when teeth are unsalvageable due to deep structural decay or widespread infection, controlled surgical removal prevents systemic complications, relieves severe discomfort, and protects adjacent dentition."

Following treatment, patients receive detailed, written post-operative guidelines covering wound management, blood clot stabilization, dietary modifications, and pain mitigation strategies. The clinical staff conducts follow-up communications within 24 hours and schedules post-operative evaluations to monitor soft tissue healing, assess bone recovery, and discuss permanent tooth replacement options. Coinciding with the service expansion, Diversey Dental Studio has launched an educational resource portal on its website featuring peer-reviewed patient guides on pre-procedure preparation, post-operative recovery protocols, dry socket prevention, and ongoing oral health maintenance.

The service is available immediately for new and returning patients. Appointments are scheduled Monday through Friday, with dedicated daily emergency time slots reserved for acute dental pain, infection, and trauma cases.
