

Smile Society Expands Care with Advanced Teeth Whitening

The introduction of this updated treatment option aims to address a growing regional demand for in-office cosmetic procedures while maintaining individualized patient safety protocols.

According to market data from the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry (AACD), professional teeth whitening remains among the most requested cosmetic dental procedures nationwide. Tooth discoloration frequently stems from routine dietary factors, such as coffee, tea, and red wine consumption, as well as natural aging and lifestyle habits. While retail cosmetic options have expanded in recent years, dental practitioners note that unsupervised treatments can present risks, including transient dentin hypersensitivity and localized gingival irritation, particularly if application trays are ill-fitting or if pre-existing dental conditions are unaddressed.

To mitigate these potential complications, Smile Society's updated procedure incorporates a preliminary clinical evaluation prior to treatment. During this initial assessment, the dental team examines the patient's oral hard and soft tissues, checks the integrity of existing dental restorations, and evaluates the origin of the discoloration to assist in determining whether the patient is a suitable candidate for bleaching protocols.

"Clinical evaluation is an essential first step before initiating any bleaching procedure," stated Dr. Emily Thompson, lead dentist at Smile Society. "The objective is to tailor the treatment approach to each patient's specific oral health profile rather than applying a single uniform protocol."

The in-office procedure involves the application of professional-grade whitening gel accompanied by protective isolation barriers designed to shield the adjacent soft tissues during application. Clinical formulations used in dental offices typically contain higher percentages of hydrogen peroxide or carbamide peroxide compared to standard over-the-counter kits, allowing the procedure to be completed in a controlled

environment. Depending on the patient's baseline shade and clinical response, custom-fitted take-home trays may also be provided to help maintain shade stability over time under professional guidance.

Beyond the immediate cosmetic application, dental practitioners often observe that patients who undergo cosmetic procedures demonstrate greater attentiveness to their overall oral hygiene habits. Maintaining routine preventive practices, such as daily brushing, flossing, and attending regular bi-annual professional cleanings, remains fundamental to long-term oral health and shade retention. By offering supervised teeth whitening in West Windsor, Smile Society aims to support ongoing patient engagement in standard preventive care.

To further assist the local community, Smile Society maintains an educational blog featuring information on routine hygiene practices, post-treatment care considerations, and common dental procedures.
